n behalf of the Village of Tinley Park, I would like to welcome you to this dynamic, progressive community. Conveniently situated at the intersection of I-80 and Harlem Avenue, a short 35-minute drive or quick train ride from downtown Chicago, Tinley park is home to well over 52,000 people, attesting to its appeal as a great place to live, work and play!

Boasting a wide variety of restaurants from fast food to fine dining; a brand new multi-use Convention Center with a complement of full-and limited-service hotels; and a growing entertainment and hospitality corridor including the renowned Tweeter Center, a Country Club and an indoor amusement park; Tinley Park has something for everyone.

Tinley Park's historic downtown district is being revitalized with new construction, storefront façade improvements, parking lot redevelopment and the creation of a town square area with complementary statue and fountain features. Nearly a third of Tinley Park is zoned for office and commercial use, with much of it along the booming I-80 Corporate Corridor in Will County. Tinley Park has seven Corporate Business Parks that are currently in development, with more plans on the horizon. DeVry Institute of Technology recently opened its newest state-of-the-art campus in Tinley Park, and Lewis University plans to open a satellite campus in September of 2002. Many well-known, respected companies have chosen Tinley Park as their location of choice.

Tinley Park is truly a world-class community. We invite you to come and see for yourself.

History





Windmills, washing machines, railways and raceways. They all have a place in the history of Tinley Park.

he town has come a long way since it was incorporated in 1892 and has seen quite a few changes, but many things have remained the same: pride, quality of life and the desire to have Tinley Park remain one of the most desirable towns in which to live.

The area within Tinley Park's original village boundaries is a designated Historic District where the village's Historic Preservation Commission encourages property owners to restore and preserve structures. The Carl Vogt Building on Oak Park Avenue is listed in the National Registry of Historic Places and several other buildings are identified in the Illinois Historic Structures survey. The northeast corner of 167th Street and Oak Park Avenue at one time was home to a fully functioning windmill.

Tinley Park was first established in 1853 as Bremen, but in 1890 began to be called Tinley Park in honor of Samuel Tinley, the community's first railroad station agent.

As a reminder of the importance that the railways played in the village's early development and economic growth, the Centennial Monument, Engine #1892, in proudly displayed at the town's first train station.

Economic development had its beginnings when a pop bottling plant opened in the 1890s, doing business for nearly 60 years at that location. Soon after, the Diamond Spiral Washing Machine Company opened its factory doors in 1905, bringing with it Tinley Park's first form of industry other than agriculture.

Tinley Park enjoys an extensive tradition of history in large part to the people, from the early pioneer and those who played a role in shaping the village to those who now continue to make history in town.

Some of those people who are on the pages of the Tinley Park history book include inventor John Rauhoff, who developed and manufactured Ironital an additive for water-proofing cement that was used in building the Hoover Dam; John Poorman, inventor of a chicken brooder that sold nationwide; and last but certainly not least, five Indianapois 500 race car drivers: Tony Bentrenhausen, sons Gary, Merle and Tony, Jr., and cousin Emil Andres.

Today, the Tinley Park Historical Society continues its ongoing research, preservation, and documentation of local artifacts and history. The Society has established a museum in the Old Zion Landmark Church, 6727 W. 174th Street, where several displays give visitors a fascinating look at Tinley Park's rich and diverse history.

Transportation

Whether it's by car, plane, bus or train; whether it's getting around town or out of town for business or pleasure, Tinley Park's location is ideal for commuters and travelers alike.


ommuting to Chicago's loop has never been easier with the Metra Commuter Rail System. Two stations; one on Oak Park Avenue and one on 80th Avenue, provide fast and frequent service, making it convenient for those who work, shop or want to visit downtown Chicago. Accessibility to Interstate 55 and Interstate 57 is close by for those who choose to drive in to the city.

When there's a need to travel by air, Tinley Park is just 25 minutes from the newly-renovated Chicago Midway Airport and 45 minutes from Chicago's O'Hare International Airport, one of the busiest with national and international flights. Meigs Field off Chicago's lakefront is 35 minutes to the north, and it's a half hour to the east to Gary (Indiana) Municipal Airport.

Traveling out of town by car is no problem thanks to the village's close proximity to several major highways. From any spot in town, it's just a few minutes to access the coast-to-coast Interstate 80, and just a few minutes more to reach several major interstates including I-294, I-55, I-65, I-90 and I-94 making it easy to travel north to Wisconsin, east to Indiana, Michigan or Ohio, west to Iowa, and south to downstate Illinois and Missouri.

The proposed I-355 extension, just a few minutes away, will further strengthen Tinley Park's superb transportation assets by providing direct access to the western and northwestern suburbs. In addition, plans are underway to connect Interstate 294 with Interstate 57.












Getting around town is convenient with many new and widened roads that provide access to any corner of Tinley Park as well as to the neighboring communities.

Motorists in Tinley Park can also leave their car at home for quick trips and take advantage of the RTA PACE bus with routes throughout the village, including to and from the Metra Commuter stations. In addition, the village offers the services of a mini bus that for a nominal fee can take residents 55 years of age and older to medical facilities in town, or in neighboring Orland Park and Oak Forest.

A host of limousine companies and taxi cabs are available for transporting you to or from the airport, sporting events, concerts, conventions or wherever you need to go for business or pleasure.





Attractions SPECIAL AND CULTURAL EVENTS







Tinley Park offers so much in the way of leisure-time activities for all ages.

ne of the largest attractions in Tinley Park is the Tweeter Center, formerly known as the World Theatre. With seating for nearly 30,000 people in a pavilion, out on the lawn or up in the suites, the Tweeter Center hosts musical and comedy entertainment all summer. Millions of people of all ages have enjoyed performances by world famous country, rock, and blues bands, contemporary names, timeless performers and today's pop groups.

The Oak Park Avenue Mainstreet Association, an organization of local business owners, plans a variety of annual events including the Caribbean Block Party, horse and carriage rides, house walks, holiday parades, and more.

Nature lovers will find outstanding cycling and hiking paths throughout town and have access to a campgrounds with a public beach and picnic area located right off I-80.

Cultural events are abundant in the area. The Park District's Arts Alive! series provides opportunities for hundreds of residents to showcase their talents through various outlets, such as the Community Chorale, the Community and Jazz Band, the Poet's Circle, the South Region Visual Arts Guild, a children's chorus and more.

Tinley Park's location is ideal for residents to take advantage of other cultural events and activities presented at nearby Moraine Valley and South Suburban Community Colleges and at museums and galleries throughout the region and in Chicago. The 65-piece Southwest Symphony Orchestra, the South Suburban Opera, Orland Park Theatre Troupe, American Dance Ballet Company, the Illinois Philharmonic Orchestra, the Illinois Conservatory of Music and Dance, the Freedom Hall, and the Illinois Theatre Center, all offer wonderful performances year-round.

People of all ages can enjoy a day at one of several miniature golf courses in town, or shoot a round at one of nearly two dozen challenging 18-hole golf courses located throughout the southwest suburban area; three of which, Graystone, White Mountain and Odyssey, are in Tinley Park.




There are also several bowling alleys in town with men's, women's, and mixed leagues, candlelight parties, and the fun of cosmic bowling with glowing pins, laser lights, fog and music.

For families with children who enjoy playing on a team, there are the Tinley Park Bobcats and the Tinley Park Bulldogs, which provide organized softball, baseball, football, and soccer teams, in addition to an organized area swim team and the Park District offerings.

Tinley Park's proximity to Chicago also makes it convenient for sports enthusiasts to see the Bears football games, Bulls basketball games, Blackhawk hockey games, Sox and Cubs baseball games and Fire soccer games, all with professional stadiums in or near the downtown Chicago area.

The Cook County Cheetahs, a minor league professional baseball team, plays its home games at Hawkinson Field in nearby Crestwood, providing hours of family fun with the game, picnic area, fireworks displays and "Birthdays at the Ballpark," where the birthday person throws out the first ceremonial pitch of the game.

Tinley Park is home to dozens of social, civic and fraternal organizations. These organizations, along with school groups, service clubs and special interest groups, offer local residents plenty of opportunities to get involved in the community through voluntary participation in the group's activities and special events, including arts and crafts fairs, fashion shows, food drives and more.

or starters, there are nearly 650 rooms in the seven hotels along and near Interstate 80. Providing outstanding accommodations, these nationally and internationally recognized hotels provide all of the amenities one needs when away from home.

If it's business that takes you to the area, the hotels provide for all of your needs, from alarm clocks and wake up services, free newspapers, irons, and safe deposit boxes to the use of fax machines, copy service and meeting rooms. Tinley Park's "hospitality corridor" is within minutes to riverboat casinos in Joliet, Route 66 Raceway, and the Chicago Motor Speedway, also in Joliet, which hosts the Tropicana 400 NASCAR race. Plus, it's only a half-hour or so drive to experience all that downtown Chicago offers.

Tinley Park's proximity and easy on-off access to several major interstates makes it the ideal place to stay when visiting the Chicagoland area.




Housing



The Park District in Tinley Park provides for an abundance of recreational opportunities and activities for all ages in the village.

ffering more than 400 programs, classes, specials events, trips and more, the Park District also maintains 39 buildings and parks that include tennis courts, baseball diamonds, picnic areas, football and soccer fields, playgrounds and much more.

Operating under the auspices of the Park District, the Vogt Visual Arts Center, a beautiful Victorian house once home to Tinley Park's first mayor, Henry Vogt, Sr., provides more than 40 art classes ranging from painting to photography, and features an art gallery and gift shop. The Park District also oversees the Tinley Park Fitness Center, complete with an indoor track, basketball, volleyball and raquetball courts, a lap pool and aerobics classes, a personal trainer and opportunities for kids' birthday parties.

Recognizing the importance of keeping up with the increasing recreational needs of a growing population, the Park District is expanding its facilities which in turn will expand its capabilities to offer Tinley Park residents an even greater amount of opportunities for quality leisure time activities.

The new Tony Bettenhausen Recreation Center, located at 171st St. and 80th Ave., transforms 70,000 square feet into several basketball and volleyball courts, jogging and walking paths, rooms for arts and crafts, and for teen and senior activities, as well as a preschool playground.



The state-of-the-art facility also houses the Bettenhausen Auto Racing Museum, which provides information on auto racing and pays tribute to the Bettenhausen family, long-time Tinley Park residents who are all well known in the racing world, by featuring family memorabilia, including Tony Bettenhausen's racing gloves and uniform.

On the same site is a beautiful 60-acre Community Park which boasts just about every outdoor amenity residents could ask for: baseball diamonds, soccer fields, 9/10ths of a mile walking/bicycle path, lighted tennis courts, basketball and sand volleyball courts.

The site also includes a \$4.4 million water park, complete with a zero depth pool and lazy river inner tube ride and the ability to accommodate up to 1,500 patrons.

Education







One of the first things people inquire about when looking for a new home is the school system, and they are pleased to hear about Tinley Park's exceptional school system, starting with award-winning pre-schools right up to colleges and universities offering undergraduate and graduate degrees.

inley Park is home to nearly 30 schools and educational facilities and its prime location offers great access to dozens of other secondary and continuing educational facilities in neighboring communities and throughout the southern and western suburbs, as well as those in the city of Chicago.

The majority of younger students in Tinley Park attend District 140 and District 146 public schools. District 140, which is comprised of eight schools, serves more than 4,700 students from kindergarten through eighth grade. District 146, which operates four of its six schools in Tinley Park, has a student population of 2,500 students and in the fall of 2001 opened its new Central Middle School. Two of Oak Forest-based District 145 schools are in Tinley Park serving elementary school aged children, as well.

Parochial elementary education is available at St. George School in Tinley Park and Cardinal Joseph Bernadin School in neighboring Orland Hills. Tinley Park's Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church also operates an elementary school.


While most of these schools offer kindergarten classes, there are also a number of outstanding facilities in Tinley Park that provide pre-school and kindergarten classes, as well as quality day care and after-school programs.

Students in Tinley Park have a number of exemplary choices when it comes to their high school education. The vast majority of students are served by Andrew High School in District 230, which has recently undergone some major renovations. Tinley Park High School, which is part of District 228, serves a portion of the village's eastern area. Some students who live along the boundaries attend either Rich South High School in Park Forest, Carl Sandburg High School in Orland Park, or Lincolnway High School in New Lenox.

Those who desire a private or parochial high school education can attend Providence Catholic, Chicago Christian, Marian Catholic, Marist, Brother Rice, Mt. Assisi, or Mother McAuley, all of which are within a half hour or so of Tinley Park.

These schools provide exceptional educational programs and opportunities for students to participate in a variety of extracurricular and athletic activities as well.

Continuing one's education is convenient for Tinley Park residents. Moraine Valley Community College in nearby Palos Hills is the seventh largest community college in Illinois. The two-year school offers an associate degree in an impressive list of studies, many extra-curricular activities and a variety of athletic programs in which to participate. Students also are served by South Suburban College, Joliet Junior College and Prairie State College.

In addition, within the past few years a number of educational institutions have opened branch facilities in Tinley Park.





Library

The Tinley Park Public Library speaks volumes to the quality of life in the village offering its patrons access to the world through its many books, memberships in various library systems, and its online services.

ocated at 171st St. and 71st Avenue, the library, which serves residents of Tinley Park and Orland Hills, houses more than 128,000 fiction, non-fiction and reference books, along with more than 2,200 books on tape for those who enjoy listening to a good book.

The library's collection also includes more than 2,500 CD's, 200 records, 1,300 pieces of sheet music, 300 song books and more than 4,000 pamphlets covering a wide variety of subject matter, as well as more than 3,500 VHS tapes and a growing DVD collection.

Tinley Park's library is a member of the Suburban Library System, which serves more than 1.6 million people in a 600 square-mile radius that includes 100 communities from most of Cook County and portions of DuPage and Will Counties. As a member of SLS, Tinley Park patrons have access to and can borrow materials from the more than 85 other SLS libraries. In addition, the Tinley Park Public Library offers inter-library loan access to all libraries throughout Illinois as well as across the United States.

The library also is a member of NetLibrary, which allows patrons to download materials to read on or off line; First Search, which features a group of 16 data bases that help locate periodical articles, books and conference proceedings; and the Electric Library, which allows patrons to search through more than 150 full-text newspapers, hundreds of magazines, 2,000 classic books and two international wire services.

The Tinley Park Library bookmobile, complete with children's and adult popular fiction, seasonal non-fiction, videocassettes, DVD's, books on tape, CD's, magazines and more, makes stops at 40 neighborhood parks and intersections throughout the two villages four days a week. Patrons who visit the bookmobile can check out and return materials, renew their library cards, and pick up reserved materials.

The library prides itself on providing the best services for patrons of all ages.

Adult programming includes guest speakers who present topics of a variety of interests, Internet classes, book discussion groups, the opportunity to meet authors and more. Children's services include a crafts program, summer reading groups, the chance to meet authors as well, book discussions, story times, writer's workshops, Magic Tree House Adventure Club and much more. Teens are welcome to attend the Café Ole coffeehouse for teens where they can enjoy a cup of java while browsing through some of their favorite books, join in on the Improv Night, meet popular authors, and get involved in the book discussions as well.

Main Street



The Main Street area of Tinley Park has for years been considered the heart of the village; a heart that is now getting a whole new life, thanks in great part to some major renovations.

ak Park Avenue is a quaint, thriving business district, home to a variety of businesses and restaurants offering visitors and shoppers the finest in merchandise, exemplary service, and a host of culinary delights from the many outstanding restaurants.

Often referred to as "the Magnificent Mile of Tinley Park," Oak Park Avenue has an atmosphere of a bygone era, a look that is being preserved and enhanced through the village-sponsored façade improvement program.

Approximately five years ago village officials took several steps to further enhance the Oak Park Avenue/Old Town area and help solidify the prosperity of the area, including forming a Main Street Business Development District and combining it with a Main Street trust fund.

This progressive thinking has paid off for the village, as it is seeing restoration plans become reality. One of the main projects is a \$5 million renovation plan for the Metra Commuter station at 174th Street and Oak Park Avenue, which includes a new 2,500-square-foot train station set back several hundred feet further east than the previous station. Its new and beautiful design, complete with a clock tower and café, will complement the area blending with the old-time theme.

Adjacent to the train station is the "Zabrocki Plaza" on Oak Park Avenue, which has been dedicated to Tinley Park's mayor. The area houses a beautiful fountain, several life-size family oriented bronze statues, landscaping, and benches, all adding much to the area that has long been known for its charm.

Retail Business





Retail in Tinley Park is plentiful and shoppers will find an array of stores ranging from fine clothing boutiques, locally-owned businesses and antique shops, to specialty stores, discount emporiums and national chains.

inley Park has it all, making it convenient yet not overwhelming. Following the direction of village leaders, retail outlets primarily are centered along the northern and western edges of town and in the historic district in an attempt to keep much of the retail traffic diverted from the residential streets. However, there are smaller neighborhood strip malls with dry cleaners, hair salons, pharmacies, quick food marts, movie rentals, and more making it convenient for nearby residents.

There are more than a dozen shopping centers in town, including Park Place, Tinley Park Plaza, Park Center, Brementowne Mall and the Historical Oak Park Avenue area. Located throughout town are large grocery and retail chains, plenty of service-related businesses like florists, real estate and insurance agencies, legal and financial offices, and banks.

There also are a number of outstanding automobile dealerships that line 159th Street, making car buying an easy task. Tinley Park's southern border is now home to the nationally known CarMax. In addition, a new Harley Davidson dealership has opened its doors near 175th Street and LaGrange Road.

Close by is Orland Square, an enclosed regional mall with nearly 175 stores and restaurants.

Shoppers are not the only ones who find it a pleasure to do business in Tinley Park. Local business owners enjoy doing business in Tinley Park for many reasons, and one is the assistance they receive from the Village and Chamber of Commerce.

Economic DEVELOPMENT







There are many reasons why Tinley Park is home to diversified corporations from printing and publishing to hi-tech and medical.

The Village of Tinley Park also works closely with the State of Illinois to offer its corporate residents opportunities to participate in the many state programs offered through the Illinois Department of Commerce and Community Affairs. These programs include Economic Development for a Growing Economy (EDGE), High Impact Businesses, Industrial Training, Capital Access, Participation Loan, Technology Venture Investment, Large Business Development, Business Development Public Infrastructure, and Technology and Environmental programs.

Tinley Park residents, as well as members of the business community, are able to enjoy a myriad of services thanks to their responsive elected leaders and a professional village staff.

he village operates under the council-manager form of government with a Mayor, Village Manger, Village Clerk and a six-member Board of Trustees.

Meeting on a regular basis, the Board of Trustees approves policies and procedures, relying on recommendations from staff and members of the Village's commissions. These commissions, comprised of knowledgeable community members, provide valuable input on matters ranging from health and environment to long-range planning and economic development. The Village Manager is responsible for implementation of these policies and procedures and overseeing the general day-to-day operations.

Considered among an elite few at the forefront of the southwestern suburban areas, Tinley Park officials' foresight and progressive thinking have made it possible for the Village to attract growing families as well as corporate offices and industrial facilities.

Its infrastructure, utilities and facilities have met the needs of a growing community and have been designed to accommodate continued and expected future growth in the area. For example, the installation of a high-quality Lake Michigan water and sanitary system and efficient roads and traffic systems, provides the village a healthy environment to foster growth.

That same commitment from the village government applies to safety, as evidenced in the police and fire departments.

People in Tinley Park can rest assured knowing that there are more than 100 full and part-time officers who take a highly visible approach to policing and a presence that commands a positive approach to deterring crime. The department operates the state's largest Neighborhood Watch program and maintains enhanced 911 services for an added measure of safety and assistance for its private and business residents.

The department also has an advisory commission, Seniors And Law Enforcement Together (SALT), that provides assistance to the police throughout the community. Trained through the department's Senior Police Academy, this group of 55-and-over residents keeps their eyes and ears open and armed with a cell phone are able to call in to the department when they spot any violations of a law.



Village officials are also proud of its paid-on-call Fire Department with an ISO Class 3 rating, the largest in Illinois with more than 100 members who are all fully trained in firefighting and emergency response. Prevention is key in this field and the department, which has celebrated more than 100 years of professional service to the community, offers various programs to families, local schools and businesses in fire prevention, protection and safety.

The Tinley Park Emergency Services & Disaster Agency (ESDA) and Civil Defense Agency work side-by-side with other professionals in the village by assisting with weather/storm spotting and tracking, medical and security services, traffic control and water recovery. Paramedic and ambulance services also stand ready around the clock for emergency situations.

The village's Public Works Department provides many behind-the-scenes services, including the maintenance of roads, storm water and sanitary sewer systems and other infrastructure. It is also the Public Works Department employees who rise in the wee hours to see that the roads are cleared of snow in time for the school buses and commuters, and who continue plowing through the night to keep village roads safe.

In addition to the many, many public services provided, Tinley Park's government is pro-development and expansion. Village officials pride themselves on streamlined planning and zoning procedures coupled with a variety of specialized programs to encourage economic expansion.

The needs of those who live or work in Tinley Park are well met by elected officials and a professional staff that has helped cultivate a well-established and highly regarded community, where future vision becomes future reality.
