History of Tinley Park




The Village of Tinley Park enjoys a rich history, thanks to the people who first settled this community, as well as those who continue to play a vital role in its development.

First established in 1853 as Bremen, the Village in 1890 was named Tinley Park in honor of Samuel Tinley, the community's first railroad station agent. The railroads played an important role in the Village's early development and economic growth, especially since the community was situated on the route of the Chicago, Rock Island and Pacific Railroad. Today, the Centennial Monument, Engine #1892, which sits at Tinley Park's first train station, is a public reminder of the railroad's key role in the Village's development.



Early economic development began to emerge when a pop bottling plant opened in the 1890s, followed by the Diamond Spiral Washing Machine Company. Both are credited with being among the first to bring to Tinley Park another form of industry other than agriculture. It was around this same time that many of the "modern conveniences" like telephone service, a municipal water system and an electric utility company came to Tinley Park.

Tinley Park's history is rich with stories of many outstanding individuals, some of whom include inventor John Rauhoff, who developed and manufactured Ironite, an additive for water proofing cement that was used in building the Hoover Dam; John Poorman, inventor of a chicken brooder that sold nationwide; and Indianapolis 500 race car drivers Tony Bettenhausen, sons Gary, Merle, and Tony, Jr., and cousin Emil Andres.

Whether you're planning a business trip to the coast, heading for vacation, or need to have cargo hauled overseas, Tinley Park is advantageously located in the middle of the nation's largest multi-modal transportation network.

Coast-to-coast Interstate 80 is only one of the reasons Tinley Park has accessibility to all corners of the world. This interstate, which runs through

Tinley Park, makes it minutes from any spot in the Village. I-80 also connects with major interstates 55, 90 and 94, which makes for easy access to and from just about any location in the state or country. Additionally, nearby is Interstate 57, which takes motorists to and from Chicago or downstate. Interstate 65 in nearby Indiana provides a direct route to the southern states. Other major highways like U.S. 45, U.S. 6, U.S. 30 and Illinois 43 link Tinley Park to cities throughout the region

Intermodal is America's fastest growing form of transportation and the Midwest's largest intermodal transportation facilities operate in suburbs adjacent to Tinley Park, providing for unlimited access to a worldwide market via truck and rail routes.

Business or pleasure travel via the air is quick and easy with Chicago's Midway Airport about a half-hour's drive north, and O'Hare International Airport about 45 minutes from Tinley Park. Plus, the Gary/Chicago International Airport, is a half-hour to the east. Over 70 million passengers take advantage of the 71 airlines serving these airports.

There also are several smaller airports, including Howell in New Lenox and Frankfort Airport just south of Frankfort, that are used primarily for single-engine aircraft. In addition the Tinley Park Helistop, which opened in 1999 and is under auspices of the Village, is open to the public for personal or business use, charters, tours and transport by helicopter.

Commuting to Chicago's Loop has never been easier with the Metra Commuter Rail System service at the newly renovated station on Oak Park Avenue and a second station on 80th Avenue. Both stations offer fast

and frequent service from as far south as Joliet to Chicago's LaSalle Street station, making it convenient for those who work, shop or want to visit downtown Chicago or other destinations along the train's route.

Getting around the Village is convenient, as well, with many new and widened roads that provide access throughout town as well as to several neighboring communities.

Residents and visitors alike can also take advantage of an excellent public transportation system. The Pace bus service, with more than 240 routes that serve more than 220 communities, offers routes throughout the Village as well as to the local commuter stations and through adjacent towns. In addition, the Village also offers services of a mini bus that for a nominal fee can take residents 55 years of age and older to nearby medical facilities. A multitude of limousine companies and taxicabs are also available.

There is a country world renowned for its hills that are alive with the sound of music and here in the southwest suburbs, there is a village that has come to be known for keeping its community alive with the sound of music...and fun!

The Park District in Tinley Park is credited with providing an abundance of recreational opportunities, activities and programs.

Among those is the Arts Alive! program, which includes the Tinley Park Community Band, Jazz Band, Community Chorale, Writer's Group, Poet's Circle, and the Vogt Visual Arts Center.

The Vogt Visual Arts Center, housed in a beautiful Victorian-style manor once home to Tinley Park's first mayor, Henry Vogt, Sr., provides more than 40 arts classes ranging from painting to photography, and features an art gallery and gift shop.

The Community Band and Jazz Band are both comprised of volunteers who perform throughout the community as well as Chicagoland. As a matter of fact, in 2004, the Community Band officially represented the State of Illinois for the dedication of the National World War II Memorial in Washington, D.C.

The fun continues with the offering of more than 1,400 programs, classes, special events, trips and more through the

Park District, which also maintains 45 buildings and parks that include football and soccer fields, volleyball and basketball courts, baseball diamonds, picnic areas, a miniature golf course and a water park.

The water park, known as White Water Canyon, is one of the newest Park District facilities and is located just west of the Bettenhausen Recreation

Center. Sprawled amongst five acres, the water park boasts of a main pool that features a zero-depth entry, a child's interactive play area, a diving well with a one-meter diving board, a three-meter drop slide with a lazy river, racing rapids, tube slide and a twisting body slide. Memberships are offered, as well as daily fees and special rates for larger groups.

Another of the newest recreational sites is Centennial Park, located in the heart of the Village. The park features many amenities, including a playground and paved walking trails that surround a 12.5-acre pond.


The Park District also oversees the Tinley Park Fitness Center, complete with an indoor track, courts for basketball, volleyball and racquetball, a lap pool, aerobics classes, personal trainer, and facilities for children's birthday parties.

The facility also houses the Bettenhausen Auto Racing Museum, which provides information on auto racing and pays tribute to the Bettenhausen family, long-time Tinley Park residents who are all well-known in the racing world, by featuring family memorabilia, including Tony Bettenhausen's racing gloves and uniforms.

On the same site is the beautiful 60-acre Community Park, which boasts just about every outdoor amenity residents could ask for: baseball diamonds, soccer fields, a walking and bicycle path, lighted tennis courts, and courts for basketball and sand volleyball.







Tinley Park is also home to large retailers like Sam's Warehouse Club, Menards, SuperTarget, and Super
