## Camp Information

Please give to your chaperones before camp. Remember you need a background check on workers! We will need a copy of the background check for anyone over 18.

This is a modified week due to the COVID-19 cancellation of the June camp. Campers will need to arrive between 11AM -12PM Monday, July 5.

Camp will be finished before 11 AM on Thursday, July 8.

No attendees who have been sick or ran a fever the previous 48 hours before camp. There will be temperature check for everyone upon arrival and campers will be checked each morning. Visits from outsiders will be limited, in an effort to keep everyone healthy.

This is a peanut free camp, fees cover canteen, no need to send extra money.

We want campers to grow and join in the fun by participating in group activities.

For safety reasons, campers should not roam alone, we like the “three buddy system!” Campers are never to be alone in the cabins, nor near the lakes, or pool.

Personal vehicles are not allowed beyond dining halls during the week.

Campers are not allowed on camp golf carts.

Remember this is a Christian camp, please dress accordingly, which means modestly, and careful of the tee shirt ads.

**Campers cannot leave the camp and return for any purpose except doctors' (or dentists') appointments or other emergencies. Parents must notify camp director if child will be leaving during the week. If a camper is sick and needs to leave camp, they may return if they are feeling better and are not contagious.**

There is no smoking/vaping/chewing tobacco products on camp grounds.

Please do not allow campers to write or deface any camp property this includes bunks!

Campers are to put their trash in trash cans. The buildings and grounds should be picked- up daily.

All canteen items must be consumed immediately at canteen time. No setting down drinks for someone else to accidentally drink after.

No campers out of cabins after curfew! Breaking this rule will mean expulsion from camp.

Chaperones/camp workers should be familiar with campers and any health concerns or behavior issues which campers may have.

Chaperones who have campers on meds, are responsible for meds and keeping meds in a safe place. If church does not send chaperone, our staff will need to be made aware of all meds.

Chaperones should be able to lead groups in daily prayer and Bible Study.

Chaperones should be positive and encouraging with campers and camp staff at all times.

Everyone should use the sunscreen.

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
