ACTS 2:42-47 ⁴² All the believers devoted themselves to the apostles teaching and to fellowship, and to sharing in meals (including the Lord's Supper), and to prayer. ⁴³ **A deep sense of awe** came over them all, and the apostles performed many miraculous signs and wonders. ⁴⁴ And all the believers met together in one place and shared everything they had. ⁴⁵ They sold their property and possessions and shared their money with those in need. ⁴⁶ **They worshiped together at the Temple each day**, met in homes from **the Lord's Supper**, and shared their meals with great joy and generosity—⁴⁷ all the while **praising God** and enjoying the goodwill of all the people. And each day the Lord added to their fellowship those who were being saved." (NLT)
