

**Isaiah 6:1-8** <sup>1</sup> It was in the year King Uzziah died that I saw the Lord. He was sitting on a lofty throne, and the train of the robe filled the Temple. <sup>2</sup> Attending Him were mighty seraphim, each having six wings. With two wings they covered their faces, with two they covered their feet, and with two they flew. <sup>3</sup> They were calling out to each other, "Holy, Holy, Holy is the Lord of Heaven's Armies! The whole earth is filled with His glory!" <sup>4</sup> Their voices shook the Temple to its foundations, and the entire building was filled with smoke. <sup>5</sup> Then I said, "It's all over! I am doomed, for I am a sinful man. I have filthy lips, and I live among a people with filthy lips. Yet I have seen the King, the Lord of Heaven's Armies. <sup>6</sup> Then one of the seraphim flew to me with a burning coal he had taken from the altar with a pair of tongs. <sup>7</sup> He touched my lips with it and said, "See, this coal has touched your lips. Now your guilt is removed, and your sins are forgiven." <sup>8</sup> Then I heard the Lord asking, "Whom should I send as a messenger to this people? Who will go for us?" I said, "Here I am. Send me." <sup>9</sup> And He said, "Yes, **go** ..." (NLT)

Sunday Morning: An hour that can CHANGE a person's life.

### **HOW TO WOW**

1. **WARM** welcome!

**Romans 16:16** "Greet each other with a sacred kiss ..." (NLT)

**Hebrews 13:2** "Don't forget to show hospitality to strangers, for some who have done this have entertained angels without realizing it!" (NLT)

What can you do?

a) Be the **FRIENDLIEST** place on the planet.

**Proverbs 15:30** "A cheerful look brings joy to the heart ..." (NLT)

b) **ACCEPT** people where they're at.

**Romans 15:7** "Therefore, accept each other just as Christ has accepted you so that God will be given glory." (NLT)

## 2. ORGANIZED Discipleship.

**Colossians 1:28-29** “<sup>28</sup> So we tell others about Christ, warning everyone and teaching everyone with all the wisdom God has given us. We want to present them to God, perfect in their relationship with Christ. <sup>29</sup> That’s why I work and struggle so hard, depending on Christ’s mighty power that works within me.” (NLT)

Our first priority is CHILDREN.

**Mark 10:13-16** “<sup>13</sup> One day some parents brought their children to Jesus so He could touch and bless them. But the disciples scolded the parents for bothering Him. <sup>14</sup> When Jesus saw what was happening, He was angry with His disciples. He said to them, “Let the little children come to me. Don’t stop them! For the Kingdom of God belongs to those who are like these children. <sup>15</sup> I tell you the truth, anyone who doesn’t receive the Kingdom of God like a child will never enter it. <sup>16</sup> Then He took the children in His arms and placed His hand on their heads and blessed them.” (NLT)

**Deuteronomy 6:4-9** “<sup>4</sup> Listen, O Israel! The Lord is our God, the Lord alone. <sup>5</sup> And you must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your strength. <sup>6</sup> And you must commit yourselves wholeheartedly to these commands that I am giving you today. <sup>7</sup> Repeat them again and again to your children. Talk about them when you are at home and when you are on the road, when you are going to bed and when you are getting up. <sup>8</sup> Tie them to your hands and wear them on your forehead as reminders. <sup>9</sup> Write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.” (NLT)

What can you do?

- a) VOLUNTEER.
- b) MODEL Christ.

For Adults—A CLEAR Discipleship Path.

**Psalms 25:4** “Show me the right path, O Lord; point out the road for me to follow.” (NLT)

**John 14:6** “Jesus said, “I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one can come to the Father except through me.” (NLT)

What can you do?

- a) LEAD one of these Discipleship Pathways.
- b) HELP in one of the Connection Booths.

3. **WORSHIP** that is passionate, purposeful and powerful.

**Psalms 5:7** "Because of your unfailing love, I can enter your house; I will worship at your Temple with deepest awe." (NLT)

**Isaiah 12:5** "Sing to the Lord, for He has done wonderful things. Make known His praise around the world." (NLT)

**1 Corinthians 14:24-25** "24... if some unbelieving outsiders walk in on a service where people are speaking out God's truth, the plain words will bring them up against the truth 25 and probe their hearts. Before you know it, they're going to be on their faces before God, recognizing that God is among you." (Mes)

**Proverbs 15:30** "... good news makes for good health." (NLT)

What can you do?

- a) Share your TESTIMONY.
- b) Share your TALENT.

**Romans 15:13** "Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you believe in Him so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit." (CSB)

## **BOTTOM LINE**

**ACTS 2:42-47** "42 All the believers devoted themselves to the apostles teaching and to fellowship, and to sharing in meals (including the Lord's Supper), and to prayer. 43 **A deep sense of awe** came over them all, and the apostles performed many miraculous signs and wonders. 44 And all the believers met together in one place and shared everything they had. 45 They sold their property and possessions and shared their money

with those in need. <sup>46</sup> **They worshiped together at the Temple each day**, met in homes from **the Lord's Supper**, and shared their meals with great joy and generosity—<sup>47</sup> all the while **praising God** and enjoying the goodwill of all the people. And each day the Lord added to their fellowship those who were being saved.” (NLT)
