Haugen and Tice named Hymn Society Fellows

GIA congratulates Marty Haugen and Adam M. L. Tice on being named Fellows of The Hymn Society in the United States and Canada!

Marty Haugen is a liturgical composer, workshop presenter, performing and recording artist, and author from Eagan, Minnesota. For the past 40 years, Marty has presented hundreds of workshops and concerts across North and Central America, Europe, Asia, and the Pacific Rim. He has over 30 recordings and more than 400 separate printed editions available through GIA Publications, Inc. and other publishers.

Marty has served as an editor or consultant to a number of GIA hymnals and has been a contributor to hymnals or supplements for many denominational groups including the ELCA and ELCIC (Evangelical Lutheran Church of America and Canada), the United Methodist Church, the Presbyterian Church USA, the Mennonite Brethren, the United Church of Christ, the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints, the United Church of Canada, the Church of England, the Church of Scotland, and Roman Catholic groups in Great Britain, Canada, Ireland, and Australia.

Adam Tice is GIA's Editor for Congregational Song and a prolific hymn text writer. As a hymnwriter, Adam's contributions have had a significant impact on the worship of churches across denominations. Over 250 of Adam's hymns have been published in five collections. His hymns have appeared in dozens of recent hymnals and his attention to undersung theme has expanded the ways that congregations engage with God and each other in worship.

In 2004, Adam was named a Lovelace Scholar by the Hymn Society of the United States and Canada. He served as a member of the Society's executive committee from 2007 to 2010 and he was the text editor for the 2020 Mennonite hymnal, *Voices Together*. Many of Adam's hymn texts are proudly published by GIA.

In its 100 year history, the Hymn Society has bestowed this highest of honors on 100 members. A significant number of Fellows of the Hymn Society have had their text collections, tune collections and books on hymnology published by GIA. Even more have had their texts, tunes and articles published in GIA's hymnals, books and magazine.
