THINK MULTIPLICATION

BIG IDEA: God's global mission demands disciples and churches that multiply.

DATE: Wednesday, May 6 and Sunday, May 10, 2026

SCRIPTURE: Gen. 22:17; Acts 6:7; Rev. 7:9-10

CONNECT

What is an idea or value that nobody was talking about five years ago, but everyone is talking about today? How did that happen?

When do you feel motivated to share about a product or service with others? Why?

WATCH THE VIDEO

What stood out to you from today's video teaching?

SCRIPTURE

Gen. 22:17 (CSB)

I will indeed bless you and make your offspring as numerous as the stars of the sky and the sand on the seashore. Your offspring will possess the city gates of their enemies.

Acts 6:7 (CSB)

So the word of God spread, the disciples in Jerusalem increased greatly in number, and a large group of priests became obedient to the faith.

Rev. 7:9-10 (CSB)

⁹ After this I looked, and there was a vast multitude from every nation, tribe, people, and language, which no one could number, standing before the throne and before the Lamb. They were clothed in white robes with palm branches in their hands. ¹⁰ And they cried out in a loud voice: Salvation belongs to our God, who is seated on the throne, and to the Lamb!

DISCUSSION

Vance said, *"We can't create movements of God – only the Holy Spirit can do that. We can obey the principles of multiplication."* Have you ever been part of something where a person was trying to manufacture a movement of God? What was that like? How could you tell the difference?

Think of the pumpkin pie story shared in the video. Are we focused on so many things that we aren't a part of the *real* thing – making disciples who make disciples? He only gave us one great commission – to go and make disciples. (And it is plural – y'all go!) Are we seeking fun or fruit?

Where have you seen spiritual multiplication done well? (Meaning, where have you seen healthy and mature Christians reproduce more healthy and mature Christians?)

WHERE DO WE BEGIN?

PRAY

The early church began by a group of believers praying together (Acts 13). How often do you pray for God's activity of multiplication? For your lost friends, co-workers and family? **Share with your group one person you are going to pray for consistently to have their spiritual eyes opened.** And be ready to be part of the answer!

MAKE DISCIPLES

What are obstacles or difficulties that hinder multiplication among followers of Jesus today?

What about for you personally – how often are you sharing Christ with those in your sphere of influence? What holds you back?

Who is in *your* circle of influence that you can pour into as a disciple of Jesus Christ? What step can you take toward greater investment in that relationship? Share ideas of how to bring up spiritual conversations and being open to the Holy Spirit's leading.

CONSIDER BEING SENT OUT

If we think of multiplication of churches, how is that happening in our church? Where do you see that happening in our community? Where are people leveraging their life for the sake of the gospel?

Remember the goal of Revelation 7:9-10 – that every nation, tribe, people and language will one day worship their Savior together at His throne!

PRAYER RESPONSE

When we seek God in prayer, He moves in power. Look over the names on the board or read them out loud. Spend time praying together for each one by name. Pray for willingness to be the answer to these prayers. Pray for divine opportunities and for the Holy Spirit to speak through us. Help us not try to manufacture anything but seek His leading in all we do and say.

Let's lift up the sails so that should the wind of the Spirit of God begin to blow in both multiplying disciples and churches, we're ready to catch the wave of the move of God.
