

DEUTERONOMY

A CHALLENGE TO A NEW GENERATION

LIFEGROUP SERIES OVERVIEW

The book of Deuteronomy is Moses' final message to Israel, challenging a new generation—one that did not witness the Exodus—to personally embrace their covenant with God as they prepare to enter the Promised Land. It emphasizes remembrance of God's past faithfulness as the foundation for renewed obedience, highlighting that their identity as God's people carries both privilege and responsibility. Obedience is framed as a loving response to God rather than mere rule-following, with clear connections between faithfulness and blessing, and disobedience and consequences. The series also stresses the importance of intentionally passing down faith to future generations through teaching and daily living, while calling for wholehearted devotion that goes beyond outward actions to a transformed heart. Ultimately, Moses' message is a call to decision, urging the people to choose life by loving and obeying God, a challenge that remains relevant for every generation.

Please note this series will be a little different since Deuteronomy is such a comprehensive book. Our focus will be on major passages and themes found throughout several chapters rather than a verse-by-verse study.
