Addendum:

Since *Iran's Energy Partners: Companies Requiring Investigation Under U.S. Sanctions Law* was published, four companies listed by FDD in this report have announced plans to stop doing business in Iran.

- LyondellBasell (Netherlands)
 - In August 2010, LyondellBasell's Board of Directors approved a decision to cease the company's operations in Iran. (*The Wall Street Journal*, August 25, 2010)

- WorleyParsons (Australia)
 - WorleyParsons announced that it will not accept any further contracts in Iran. (*WorleyParsons Media Release*, August 25, 2010)

- Tupras (Turkey)
 - Tupras reported to the United States Department of State it cancelled its contracts to supply Iran with gasoline in August 2010. (*U.S. Department of State*, September 30, 2010)

- The Linde Group (Germany)
 - The Linde Group announced on September 10, 2010 that it decided to cease all of its activities in Iran. (*The Wall Street Journal*, September 10, 2010)

- ThyssenKrupp (Germany)
 - German industrial conglomerate, ThyssenKrupp, announced on September 23, 2010 that it decided to cease all business relations with Iran in support on international sanctions. (*Dow Jones*, September 23, 2010)

- Inpex Corporation (Japan)
 - News reports announced on September 30, 2010 that Inpex was planning to fully withdraw from its ongoing project in Iran. (*AFP*, September 30, 2010)
