

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-08-08**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE CITY OF CLAY, ALABAMA
FY 2026-2027 REBUILD ALABAMA ACT ANNUAL TRANSPORTATION PLAN**

WHEREAS, the Alabama Legislature enacted the Rebuild Alabama Act, Act No. 2019-2, providing additional funding for transportation infrastructure improvements throughout the State of Alabama; and

WHEREAS, Section 23-8-8 of the Code of Alabama 1975 requires a qualified municipality to adopt an annual transportation plan no later than August 31 for the succeeding fiscal year, approved by an affirmative vote of a majority of the municipal governing body; and

WHEREAS, the annual transportation plan is required to identify projects for which expenditures are intended to be made during the next fiscal year based upon estimated revenues available for those purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Clay has determined that the preservation, repair, maintenance, and resurfacing of municipal streets is necessary to maintain the City's transportation infrastructure and protect the safety and welfare of the traveling public; and

WHEREAS, the City anticipates expending Ninety-Six Thousand Four Hundred Seventy-Nine Dollars and Seventy-Nine Cents (\$96,479.79) during Fiscal Year 2026-2027 for municipal street paving and resurfacing;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLAY, ALABAMA, as follows:

Section 1. Adoption of Transportation Plan

The City Council hereby adopts the attached City of Clay FY 2026-2027 Rebuild Alabama Act Annual Transportation Plan, which is incorporated into this Resolution as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2. Authorized Project

The City hereby designates the Citywide Street Paving and Resurfacing Project as its planned Rebuild Alabama Act transportation project for Fiscal Year 2026-2027. The City anticipates expending \$96,479.79 toward paving, resurfacing, pavement repair, and related improvements to public municipal streets within the City of Clay.

Section 3. Administration

The Mayor and appropriate City officials and employees are authorized to take those administrative actions reasonably necessary to implement the Annual Transportation Plan, procure authorized paving and related services in accordance with applicable law, maintain required financial and project records, and carry out the purposes of this Resolution.

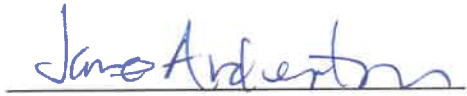
Section 4. Public Posting

The City Clerk is directed to maintain and post the adopted Annual Transportation Plan in accordance with the public availability and posting requirements of the Rebuild Alabama Act.

Section 5. Effective Date

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

ANNUAL TRANSPORTATION PLAN

Purpose

Pursuant to the Rebuild Alabama Act, Act No. 2019-2, and Section 23-8-8 of the Code of Alabama 1975, the City Council of the City of Clay, Alabama hereby adopts this Annual Transportation Plan for Fiscal Year 2026-2027.

This plan identifies the transportation infrastructure project for which the City intends to expend Rebuild Alabama Act funds during the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2026, and ending September 30, 2027.

The City intends to utilize \$96,479.79 for the preservation, maintenance, repair, resurfacing, and improvement of municipal streets within the City of Clay.

FY 2026-2027 Transportation Project

Project Name	City of Clay Citywide Street Paving and Resurfacing Project
Project Type	Municipal Street Preservation, Maintenance, Repair, and Resurfacing
Project Location	Public municipal streets located within the corporate limits of the City of Clay, Alabama.
Project Description	The City of Clay intends to perform street paving and resurfacing improvements during Fiscal Year 2026-2027. Work may include milling, leveling, patching, base repair, asphalt resurfacing, pavement edge repair, roadway preparation, traffic control, pavement markings, and other work directly related to the repair, preservation, resurfacing, and improvement of municipal streets. Street segments included in the paving program shall be selected based upon pavement condition, traffic volume, public safety considerations, available funding, coordination with other public improvements, and the City's assessment of transportation infrastructure needs.

Supplemental Funding. The City may supplement Rebuild Alabama Act funds with other legally available municipal, state, or federal transportation funds if necessary or desirable to complete the paving program.

All Rebuild Alabama Act funds expended pursuant to this plan shall be used only for purposes authorized by applicable Alabama law.

The City shall maintain appropriate accounting and project records documenting the receipt and expenditure of Rebuild Alabama Act funds. Funds shall be accounted for and expended in accordance with applicable statutory requirements and shall be subject to audit as provided by law.

Public Availability

Following adoption by the City Council, this Annual Transportation Plan shall be made available to the public and posted as required by Section 23-8-8, Code of Alabama 1975, including posting at appropriate municipal facilities and on the City's official website, if available.
