FIRE DEPARTMENT MESSAGE

The spring open burn period is still going and will end on May 30th unless the county declares a red flag warning and then all burning will cease. Permits are available online at www.elkridgcity.org. Be sure to watch the weather conditions and verify the burn approval on the county burn line. The phone number is on the permit. Make sure before you burn that you have your permit readily available if asked for it by Law Enforcement or the FD. Please make sure your burn is kept manageable, has adult supervision, a way to put it out quickly and is out by sundown.

FIRE DEPARTMENT MESSAGE-CONTINUED

We have been working with the state Division of Forestry and State Lands to mitigate overgrowth in the city and we get credit on our agreement with them for all the cleanup and dead growth that is taken out during these open burn periods. For those residents that use these permits, please focus on dead material and clearing around your home to reduce the dead fuel. This will help you maintain a safe zone around your property. An added benefit of cleaning up the city through our yards and surrounding area is it keeps our city looking nice.

School will be out at the end of the month and the kids will be out even more so please watch for balls and bikes as there is usually a child close by. ATV and UTV accidents have been on the rise. Be sure to have all your young operators familiar with the equipment and under adult supervision at all times.

We have many openings for EMTs on the Fire Department and encourage everyone with an interest in this exciting opportunity to see the new application on the Fire Department tab on the city web page. The application can be filled out and emailed back. With our city growing, our medical and fire call volume has gone up dramatically and will continue to increase. We have training options for all state certifications and are one of the best reimbursed volunteer departments in the county. Come be part of our growing team. 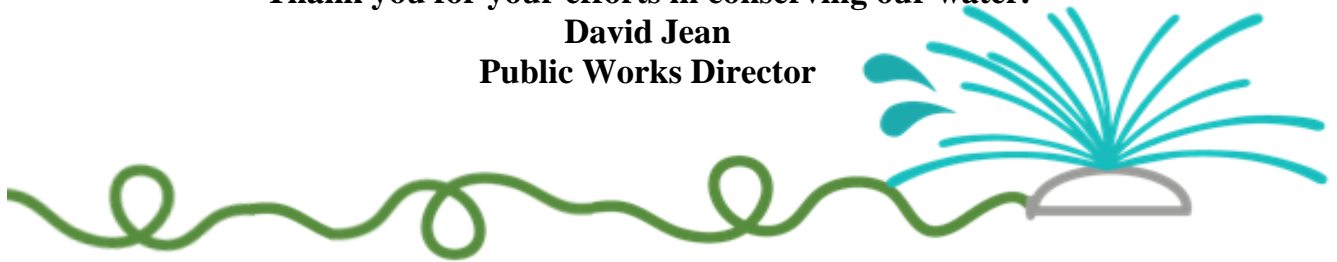
has lots of good information and a map showing how much water your lawn needs. Please keep this link in your favorites folder and refer to it often. A healthy lawn has deep roots. This site:

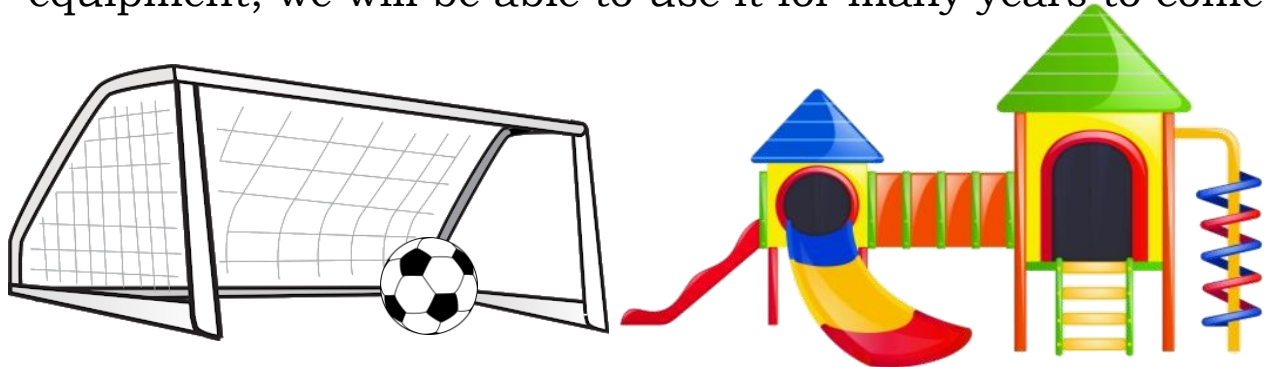
