Here's some recommendations to conserve water:

- Run full loads (dishwashers and washing machines)

- Wait to water
- Plan now for the irrigation season and consider implementing water-wise landscaping or purchasing a smart irrigation controller

FIRE DEPARTMENT MESSAGE

We want to thank everyone that is participating in the City Celebration! The support is appreciated! We are looking for more volunteers, especially those that want to be an EMT. This is a great opportunity to give back to the community, learn a new skill and provide a critical service to those having a medical emergency. We are working to become an ambulance transport agency and our great volunteers are how we make it happen. See the Fire Department tab on the city website for an application. If you have been watching the news lately, the entire state is in a severe drought situation and as of May 27, 2021 we have had 227 wildfires across the state which is unheard of and all preventable as they were mostly human caused. Please take extra precautions as you travel and camp this summer. Make sure your fires are out, if allowed, and cold before you leave the camp spot. Be extremely careful even around your home. Gas firepits are recommended for backyard use. If you have wood, please make sure to keep sparks contained with a screen cover and have a hose ready everytime you use your pit. Critical time can be spent getting a hose if it's not already in place and it's needed. Also, trash is not to be burned in your fire pit, because of the ashes that it causes. The ashes can potentially leave your pit and start a fire some distance away. If you like to shoot, please keep away from exploding targets and pay careful attention to any new restrictions that may be in your favorite shooting area.

With the fire danger again this year, fireworks will be banned within the city for the July Holidays. The fire department members will be out both holidays as a reminder that NO FIREWORKS are ALLOWED. We will also be keeping the city Fire Hazard signs updated so pay attention to them.

Summer means the kids are out fulltime. Please watch your speed around the city, especially around the parks and walking paths as a ball or bike usually has a child close by.

Have a safe summer and don't let a little mistake ruin your summer fun with family and friends!!

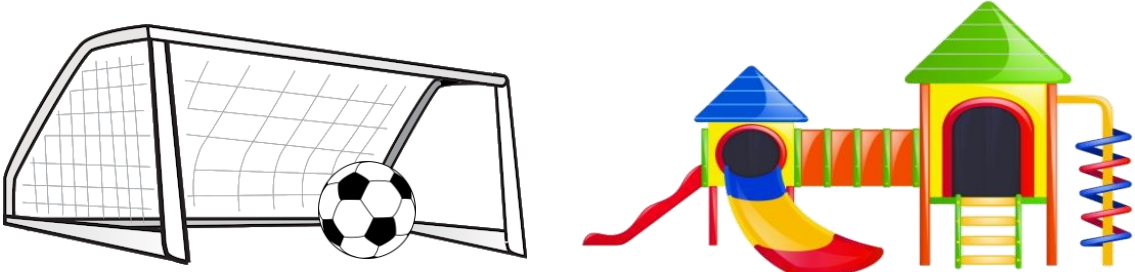

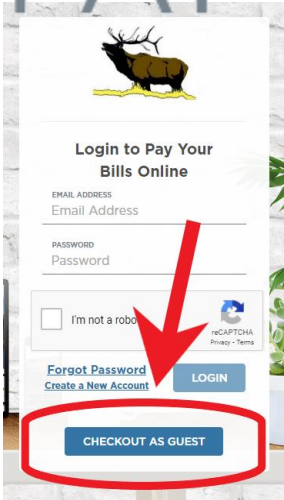
