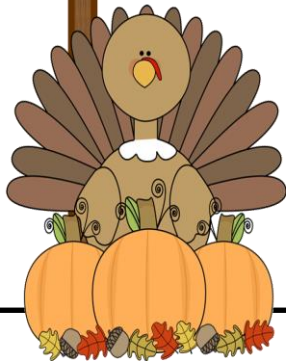

From 9/16/21 thru 10/15/21 Utah County Sheriff Department responded to 65 calls for service in the city of Elk Ridge. These calls included.

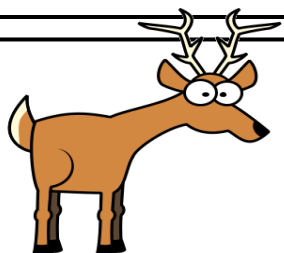

DO NOT PARK ON THE ROAD

The city code regarding snow removal is as follows Parking Prohibited For Snow Removal: In order to facilitate efficient and safe removal of snow from city streets, it is unlawful for the owner or driver of any motorized or non-motorized vehicle, trailer, boat, or other transportation device, to be parked during snow removal activities between November 1 and March 1. Any vehicle that is parked in violation of this section may, without prior notice, be removed immediately at the owner's expense. (Ord. 17-1, 1-10-2017)
