I got doored by an Uber passenger yesterday... I wrote to Uber and received an underwhelming response. Not even a "I hope you're okay..." Gotta love those cold greedy cretins.

Dear Uber, I commute via bicycle every day in San Francisco. Today, I was struck by the passenger-side door of an Uber driver's car. The Uber driver did not pull over before he let his passenger exit his car. Instead, he let the passenger exit the car while he was stopped at a red light behind several other cars. Because he did not pull to the side, there was ample space for bicycles to ride by on the right side of the stopped cars, as there should be since the street was a designated Shared Bicycle street. Shared Bicycle streets are designed to accommodate the widths of both bicycles and cars in the travel lane. The passenger that struck me with the car door left the scene immediately and I did not get her information. I dismounted and walked to the sidewalk, and I saw that the driver had pulled over, close to where the incident occurred, to inspect his car. I approached the driver and asked for his insurance and name, and he did not give that information to me. Clearly, both the passenger and driver did not want to cooperate and were not concerned about my well-being or damage to my bike -- I trust Uber as a company does not share these values. To ensure the safety of cyclists, drivers and passengers in San Francisco, I strongly encourage Uber to include bicycle safety in its driver education program. Unfortunately, the driver's car looked brand new and did not have license plates, however, I did record the following information: intersection was Townsend and 2nd St, car was a black Honda, time was approximately 6:10pm (Oct 7th), driver was a tall male with short dark hair. With satellite tracking technology, I'm confident that you will find the negligent parties involved. As a result of this incident, I will be getting a full bike-tune up and replacing parts to return my bike to

It is (likely) impossible for Uber to determine who was at that corner at that time. You say approximately 6:10pm, but it sounds like it could have easily been ten minutes earlier or later making it unlikely that they can pinpoint the the driver. Particularly since you didn't provide the model of the vehicle. Black Honda could be one of dozens of different models. It's also very possible that the driver had ended the trip before arriving at that corner or sometime after.

Please keep in mind that drivers have zero control over what passengers do. There have been many times that I've been sitting an intersection and all of the sudden a rider decides we're "close enough" and just bails out of the car.

I approached the driver and asked for his insurance and name, and he did not give that information to me.

You should have called the police if the driver refused to provide you his information. This was a traffic accident, regardless of who is at fault this person left the scene of an accident. Frankly, the fact that you didn't call the police makes this story slightly suspect. I'm sure Uber shares the same sentiment.

Could have been an Uber logo on the car but the customer could have been from Lyft or Sidecar or just the drivers sister getting dropped off.

And Thus you have just stumbled unto one of the short comings of this whole "Ride Share" scheme. no accountability. Ever wonder why cabs are painted so weird and have big numbers all over them? It is for exactly this reason. To be able to identify them when they are involved in shady business. The PUC has allowed TNC cars to have removable trade dress and no provisions for a unique identifier for each vehicle.

I would urge you to go tell your story at an upcoming meeting of the PUC as they examine the rules they have put in place around TNC vehicles. They are meeting November 4th.

I have read a lot about cops handing out tickets and bicyclists angry at Lyft drivers for being in the bike lane, but late at night there is hardly anywhere else to pull over to drop off a passenger. If all of the parking spots are taken downtown, the only option I see is the crosswalk which is equally as dangerous. All I see are complaints with no advice from Lyft, Uber, or other drivers on proper ways to pick up and drop off passengers, so here I am on Reddit seeing if anyone has any advice on what is the proper way to handle this situation. BTW I drive in Sacramento.

Lifelong bicycle commuter here. I'm too lazy to find the actual CVC but, a vehicle can stop in a bike lane for the loading/unloading of passengers.

That being said, since you drive in Sacramento, I'm sure you're aware that often times your passengers aren't ready for you when you arrive, and you're going to be waiting

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around for them ... that isn't passenger loading/unloading, that's you being parked in the bike lane.

As far as unloading goes: if you're close to the end of the block, and there is a lot of trafficonsider pulling around to the cross street so that you won't be forcing cyclists out into vehicle traffic.

In both cases (loading and unloading): don't underestimate the speed of a rider. If you passed a cyclists a block back, they've caught up with you as you were slowing down. Signal early (which is required by law anyway) so that the cyclist knows that you are goin to merge into your lane; and if you passed them within a half-block, realize that they are **right there** since you have slowed down, and don't pull into the bike lane until they have passed (and for god sake, tell your passengers not to open the door until it is safe to do so).

She wasn't happy at all. Said other drivers drop her there. I informed her I'm not going to risk \$150 ticket for her \$5 ride. (in my mind, I said suck it up fatty, the 30 feet is the bare minimum you should be walking, at least once per hour...goddam)

Her pick up too, was on the side of a busy 2 lane road in rush hour, no-stop zone. Luckily there was a driveway just after her where I could pull in. 5 stars? You can guess the answer.

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

I learned this lesson the hard way back in 2018. Was involved in a 4 car pile-up that was not my fault. In Florida, all cars besides the first are given a careless driving ticket. My damage was more in the front of my car then the rear, and even though I had full coverage, my insurance company refused to pay out, then canceled my policy, then the lady in front of me tried to sue me for her damages. It was a big mess and one that I don't wish to be in ever again.

If it's a bad bad accident, and someone gets seriously injured... they're coming after you personally to collect all damages. Your regular policy will fight tooth and nail saying that you violated your agreement by using your car for commercial purposes. I don't recommend anyone try to get away with this by just keeping delivering a secret.

It depends on how militant your city is on enforcing these things. Judging by the fact that you are holding a ticket, I'd say your city's up there. I dash in San Francisco and Downtown Los Angeles. SF is crazy with the tickets and LA seldom writes any. I've gotten extremely accustomed to the system in San Francisco and have talked to the enforcement managers many times about dashers getting tickets.

My best advice is to tend to your vehicle like it's a child you're bringing to work. There are situations where I have to loose a direct line of sight like picking up from malls, but always try to keep and eye on your car. If you see parking enforcement, even BLOCKS away, tell the restaurant you'll be back and go shoe them away like a fly. They usually won't ticket you if you're there telling them to fuck off.

Next is what to do when you get one. Don't put up with that shit. As a delivery driver, you technically count as a commercial vehicle. Commercial vehicles can qualify for different rulings, so always make sure to dispute tickets and explain yourself. I've literally had success with stating "I'm a dasher, what in the world is wrong with you guys" lol. You bring their city a service and economy, act slightly entitled. You're dealing with a bureaucracy.

If you do end up having to pay it, don't forget to claim it on taxes come April. It's a real operating expense and if they're gunna force you to pay fines to do business in their market, you can claim it on your tax return. Good luck homie.



# What, if anything, is Lyft doing to prevent their drivers from blocking bike lanes and endangering cyclists and other riders? Lyft HQ Question (self.Lyft)

**TL;DR** - The title says it all. Lyft drivers are constantly blocking bike lanes. I think Lyft could help to prevent their drivers from doing this and their riders from initiating/ending rides in bike lanes.

- - -

First, this is a genuine question. I'm not trying to hate on Lyft and call them out. I just want to know what they're doing, and if that's nothing, then encourage them to think about ways to help the situation. With that out of the way, onto my point.

As a cyclist in a moderate-large city (Boston), I constantly see cars parked/stopped in unprotected bike lanes. This blocks the path for cyclists, forcing them to divert into car lanes, thereby dramatically increasing the danger cyclists are in. Sometimes the car isn't directly in the bike lane, leaving enough room to the right for bikes to pass, but this actually creates a potentially *more* dangerous situation, where the cyclist tries to pass on the right, only for a passenger to open their door and hit them. I know from experience from someone exiting their ride share...

Not only is this dangerous for the cyclists and cars in the road, but it's illegal (or at least fineable) here in Boston and presumably elsewhere. From the Boston website on cycling laws: "In the City of Boston, you are not allowed to stop or park in a bike lane and can get a parking ticket for doing so." I believe some cities are (rightfully) cracking down on *any* cars stopped in bike lanes for *any* reason, immediately issuing tickets for doing so.

While it's impossible to know the reason a car is stopped in the bike lane, I know that many times it's because the car is a ride share like Lyft or Uber. As a Lyft rider, I've been put in this situation several times, where the driver stops to let me out in the bike lane. And as a bystander, I've suspected many stopped cars to be ride shares; I see the glowing Lyft/Uber signs and I see passengers get into the car in the back seat while the driver does not get out.

All of the above said, I can't help but wonder what, if anything, Lyft is doing to combat their drivers from stopping in bike lanes or their riders from calling rides in bike lanes. I'd love to know the thought processes behind those actions, whatever they are. It'd also be great to see tangible evidence of those actions and how they've helped the situation. And if Lyft isn't

actively addressing the problem, I would encourage them to do so in some of the ways I sugg-

- Prevent/discourage rides from beginning or ending in places with unprotected bike lanes
  - I'd imagine it should be possible to detect whether the pick-up/drop-off point for a adjacent to a bike lane, so simply preventing this from happening and forcing the r begin/end elsewhere makes sense to me. This could work similarly to airports, whe initiate a ride from just anywhere, there are designated places you can.
  - Alternatively, the app could suggest alternate locals when initiating a ride.
- Educate riders and drivers about cyclist safety.
  - For riders, I think the occasional notification/pop-up about being aware of cyclists a useful. For example, if a rider requests a ride near unprotected bike lanes, they show warning with something along the lines of "Watch out for cyclists when entering an your car" or "On your next ride, we suggest setting your pick-up/drop-off points he that your driver does not block the bike lane and endanger cyclists". I know that m riders/drivers are blissfuly unaware of the danger that blocking bike lanes can put I think a gentle nudge like this is absolutely warranted.
  - For drivers, this could be along the same lines. Perhaps things like suggesting to th watch for cyclists. Or looking for areas without bike lanes to pull over. The kind of training/verification that drivers go through (whatever that might be) could include like this.
- Encourage cities (and all municipalities, for that matter) to build protected, separated bil
  - Not only do these improved bike lanes help prevent cars from blocking cyclists, but just in general far safer and more enjoyable for everyone.
  - There are (at least here in Boston) long stretches of road with painted bike lanes the
    making it difficult (if not impossible) for a driver to pull over without blocking a bike
    rending the above suggestions effectively useless. Fully protected and separated bit



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

I want to express how disappointed I am with Uber Eats Driver app and their support for Drivers. Today I received a parking citation for parking in the bike lane whilst on the job and received no support or help from Uber eats even though they are half responsible for setting me up with a order at a chick fil a that was in the middle of a mustache beer festival in Wrigleyville! The only possible way to pick up the order was to park illegally in the bike lane since all of the parking zones for two entire city blocks were closed off with barriers. Uber eats only cares about their bottom line and sets up drivers in bad situations because they just want to make the dollar and don't care if there's a huge festival going on between you and your pick up. There are several times a week I receive orders that pretty much demands that I have to park illegally to complete the pick up in the city of Chicago. For example, Small Cheval at 150 North riverside plaza in downtown Chicago. There is no parking on Randolph street so drivers have to park on the bike lane. Uber eats knows this but they keep sending drivers there anyways.

I recommend that drivers CANCEL orders whenever there is no parking available during pickups or else face the consequences of the law and don't expect any help from Uber eats either.
