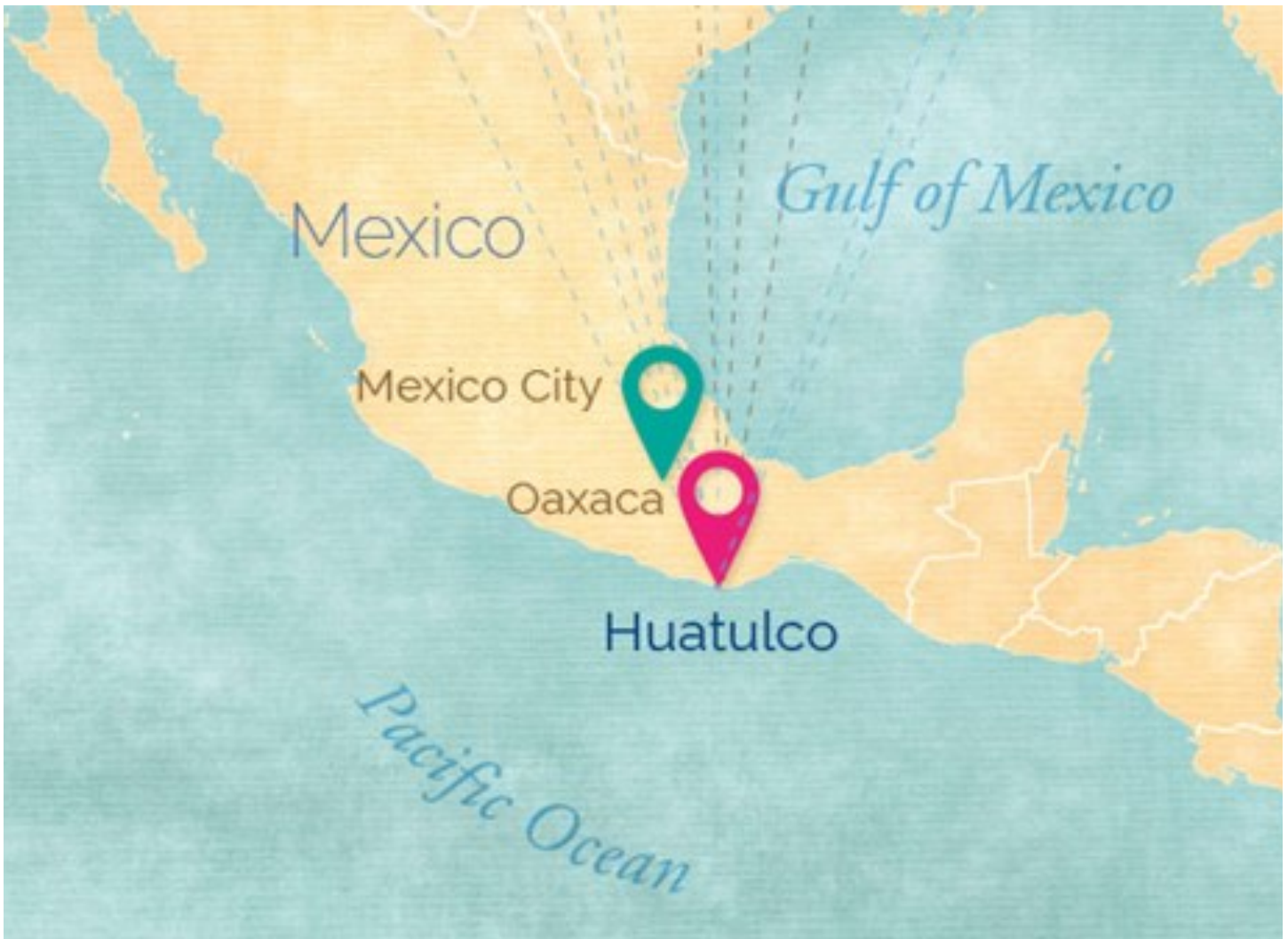

Located in the state of Oaxaca at the edge of the Sierra Madre Mountains, Huatulco spans 20 miles of dramatic Mexican coastline. The Pacific Ocean laps the shores of Huatulco's stunning beaches, spread across nine bays. Although not as well-known as some of the country's megaresorts, this tropical paradise boasts a world-class tourism infrastructure of luxury hotels, restaurants, nightclubs, a golf course, the charming and authentic town of La Crucecita, and the small port of Santa Cruz.

DISCOVER HUATULCO

Huatulco is one of Mexico's most relaxed destinations. Exploring its nine bays will introduce you to its 36 beaches and numerous inlets and coves, each with its own unique setting and ecology. Some bays are accessible only by boat, but all are noted for their golden sand and clear, warm water. The calm bays are ideal for a full range of water sports, including swimming, snorkeling, jet-skiing, windsurfing, and sailing. Or pick a remote and expansive beach you can have to yourself. If you're a diver or snorkeler, you'll be pleasantly surprised by the area's rugged shoreline. Many coral reefs create pockets of diverse undersea life just waiting to be explored. Farther from shore, excellent deep-sea fishing awaits.

Climate

The year-round temperature average for Huatulco is 86°F. The period from April through August sees the highest temperatures, which hover in the low 90s; however, March and September approach the same level of heat, with temperatures averaging in the high 80s. Travelers who want to avoid the heat might want to schedule their trip in the cooler months, November to February, when daytime temperatures average between 82 and 84.

Casa Mayor

An enjoyable place for dinner, coffee or a drink with the background of acoustic live music and the best sight of the main square. Classic romantic Mexican music is the cornerstone of the program every night, making it just perfect for couples celebrating anniversaries and honeymoons.

La Crema

ACTIVITIES

Finca La Gloria Coffee Plantation and Waterfall Swim

Discover where the best coffee grains are grown on a tour of the Finca La Gloria coffee plantation, located in the Sierra Madre de Oaxaca. This Huatulco day trip to the southern mountain range includes a refreshing dip under the majestic waterfalls of Llano Grande, an optional visit to a local butterfly farm and a traditional Oaxacan lunch.

Huatulco Jungle ATV Tour

One of the more popular tours in Huatulco, this beaches and bays ATV excursion lasts approximately 4 hours and takes you along the protected reserves of Maguey Bay and Organo Bay. You will also be taken up to the El Faro (lighthouse) to witness the gorgeous coastal views before taking a refreshing swim in the ocean.

Huatulco Jet Ski Tour

Extremely popular, this half-day, 2.5 hour, Jet Ski excursion takes you on an exciting tour along four of Huatulco's nine bays. While touring, you will get an opportunity to hop off your Jet Ski and do some snorkeling before grabbing a bite at one of the many beachside restaurants found in Maguey Bay.

Visit Hagia Sofia

This unique excursion takes you on a tour through Huatulco's renowned eco preserve, Hagia Sofia. Travel through over 60 varieties of organically grown flora as you experience the majestic qualities of this natural sanctuary and indulge in delicious handmade meals.

SHOPPING

Santa Cruz

This area offers the traditional Mexican market. Offering rows of vendors selling Mexican artesanias including dresses, bags, pottery, blankets, glassware, hammocks, t-shirts, jewelry, and more. Many of the vendors carry the exact same items so you can often get your bartering hat on here and work on getting the best bang for your buck.

Chahue

Plaza Chahue, although primarily commercial storefronts, includes one shop worth mentioning: Artesanias La Fortuna. This shop offers a variety of handmade jewelry and onyx fixtures at great prices! If you're willing to lug an onyx framed mirror or onyx light fixture home on the plane – this shop is a must see.

La Crucecita

This is the town center offering your classic Mexican town square experience – complete with artisan shops galore! Here you'll find every kind of tourist shopping you could want. You'll find hand-painted pottery as well as the signature Oaxacan black pottery called barro negro. Just beyond the artisan-based shopping square, there is a small indoor shopping mall.

One last stop you may want to make while in La Crucecita is Telar Escobar which can be found on the corner of Cocotillo and Bougainvillea. This shop is a local weavers shop that makes beautiful Mexican clothing, bedding, and tablecloths on site. You will find the widest selection of Mexican clothing here...and probably the best quality in the region.
