

CONDUCTIVE HEARING LOSS



1 WHERE DOES IT OCCUR?

This type of hearing loss occurs in the middle ear space.

2 CAN IT BE CORRECTED WITH SURGERY?

Yes, depending on the medical issue it may be corrected with surgery.

3 WHAT CAUSES THIS TYPE OF HEARING LOSS?

Your hearing loss could be due to several different issues (i.e. middle ear fluid, a growth in the middle ear, or a fixation of the three small bones in your middle ear). An Otolaryngologist is trained to diagnose middle ear conditions.

4 DO I NEED TO TREAT MY HEARING LOSS WITH AMPLIFICATION?

Untreated hearing loss can lead to depression, social isolation, anxiety, anger, or frustration. It has also been linked to cognitive decline. Once the status of your middle ear has been evaluated amplification may be of benefit to you.
