

MIXED HEARING LOSS



1 WHERE DOES IT OCCUR?

This type of hearing loss occurs in the middle and inner ear space.

2 CAN IT BE CORRECTED WITH SURGERY?

Yes, depending on the medical issue the middle ear or conductive portion of your hearing loss may resolve.

3 WHAT CAUSES THIS TYPE OF HEARING LOSS?

A combination of hearing loss occurring in the nerve of hearing as well as the middle ear space. There are several medical conditions that can cause this type of hearing loss. Please follow up with an otolaryngologist (ENT physician).

4 DO I NEED TO TREAT MY HEARING LOSS WITH AMPLIFICATION?

Untreated hearing loss can lead to depression, social isolation, anxiety, anger, or frustration. It has also been linked to cognitive decline. Once the status of your middle ear has been evaluated amplification may be of benefit to you.
