

SENSORINEURAL (NERVE) HEARING LOSS



1 WHERE DOES IT OCCUR?

This type of hearing loss occurs in the inner ear.

2 CAN IT BE CORRECTED WITH SURGERY?

This is a permanent type of hearing loss. There is no surgery or medication that will improve your hearing.

3 WHAT CAUSES THIS TYPE OF HEARING LOSS?

Causes may include changes in the inner ear due to the aging process, noise exposure, and/or genetics.

4 DO I NEED TO TREAT MY HEARING LOSS WITH AMPLIFICATION?

Untreated hearing loss can lead to depression, social isolation, anxiety, anger, or frustration. It has also been linked to cognitive decline.
