Your Objectives As A Disciple

Discipleship is not a program but a process

At the end of twelve to eighteen months with your D-Group, you should expect to be prepared in the following disciplines:

1. Utilize a well-developed ***Bible reading/study*** plan that guides you to hear God's Word authoritatively in your life, and to respond to His teaching. (2 Timothy 2:2, Ephesians 4:11-13)
2. Grow in a deeply relational ***prayer life*** in which you speak with God and listen to Him speak to you constantly.
3. Faithfully ***worship*** God at every opportunity with your church family.
4. Participate in Biblical community through ***connection*** with a small group Bible study.
5. Develop strong bonds of ***Christian fellowship*** with your D-Group members and others with whom you will cherish and build on for life.
6. ***Live missionally***, taking every opportunity that God brings you to share your "Jesus story" and/or the Gospel so that lost people will come to know Jesus.
7. Serve others and the church by ***discovering and using your spiritual gifts, being empowered by the Holy Spirit***.
8. ***Repeat*** this process. (Matthew 28:18-20)
