Description

When FCA renovated the 245,000 SF interior of the historic Daniel L. Herrmann Courthouse, the architects incorporated and harmonized the new with the old. The design preserves the distinguished Neo-classical architecture while integrating modern functionality in all of the workspaces. The courthouse comprises four floors and a mezzanine. The entrance features a grand two-story atrium that is now the heart of Young Conaway's public and collaboration areas. The design team helped restore the original elliptical bronze staircase railings, and the refurbished natural stone and chiseled marble in the atrium augment the streamlined interior. Additional customized decorative metal features, such as the sconces, balance the original design elements.


