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D. DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT

On a separate page, give a brief description or outline (1-2 pages) of your project that includes the following.

1. **Introduction:** gives a statement of what is to be done, the significance of the project, and the overall purpose of the project. This section should also include background information regarding previous work you may have done on this project and if your study is part of any larger research projects being overseen by your faculty mentor.
2. **Rationale:** provides preliminary review of the literature on the topic and identifies any gaps you intend to fill. Essentially, how do you justify your research?
3. **Objectives:** This should outline the aims of your study and your basic research questions. These should be specific, realistic, and unambiguous operational statements about how your research will be conducted.
4. **Methodology:** This should include any planned activities, techniques & methods being employed, how you plan to analyze your data, and a timeline for your project.
