## **Line Guidelines**

The PBS KIDS line is an IMPORTANT design device. Its purpose is to creatively lead the eye from one thing to another. It also frames and divides important information.

The PBS KIDS line is not just any other line. It has rules.

- Avoid using the line as just a design element. Put it to Work!
- The line should lead you to important information.
- The line weight/thickness is the same as the white line around the PBS KIDS logo.
- The line is mostly made of right angles but it also has slightly skewed angles. This is a fun way to give the line character, but don't go overboard.
- The line should be white unless it's on a white background, then it can be a color that compliments the other elements (PBS KIDS Green is a good chioce.)
- The line isn't made on an Etch-A-Sketch. It doesn't have to enter and leave the frame. There can be more than one line in the frame.

The example below show how the line can be used.

#### Going to a Restaurant



Make your next visit to a restaurant an interactive learning experience for your kids. Use these activities to practice reading and literacy skills while enjoying a good meal! (Note: terms in **bold italics** are terms you may want to explain to young children)

#### **On-the-Go Tips:**

#### 1. Ordering:

- a. Look at and read through the menu items together. Are there any new words on the menu? Does anyone know what they mean?
- b. Have everyone at the table say what he or she is ordering.

#### 2. Menu Word Hunts

- a. Look over the menu and have your children hunt for words or letters you find on the menu.
- b. What words are most common? Work together to count how often different words appear to figure out which one is most frequently used.

#### 3. Customer Reviews:

- a. After the meal you can ask each child to review their meal; telling you what they ate and if they liked it or not. Would they order that item again? Why or why not?
- 4. Bring along a few literacy related printables from pbs.org/read

#### **Activities**

#### 1. Wordfind (activity sheet)

- a. Can you find all the words in the grid? Are there any items in the word find that are also at the restaurant?
- 2. Picture—Word Connection Restaurant themed (activity sheet)
  - a. Draw a line between the picture and the word. Plate, waiter, etc.

#### 3. Make Your Own Menu (activity sheet)

a. Write or draw your favorite things to eat. Have you had this meal before, or is it something from your imagination?



## **Shape Guidelines**

Like the line, simple geometric shapes are an IMPORTANT design device. Shapes can be used to contain information or as subject headers. They can also be used to accent or spruce up a design.

- On a white background, please use a colored-shape behind the PBS KIDS logo.
- Irregular rectangles are a great way to anchor text and graphics on the page.
- When the lines and shapes combine, avoid making parallel lines. Slightly skew the shape or the line to show a difference in their angles
- Shapes are created with slightly skewed angles.



Shapes should be simple and just slightly skewed.






The line thickness should be consistent.
