## 14. Fais Dodo

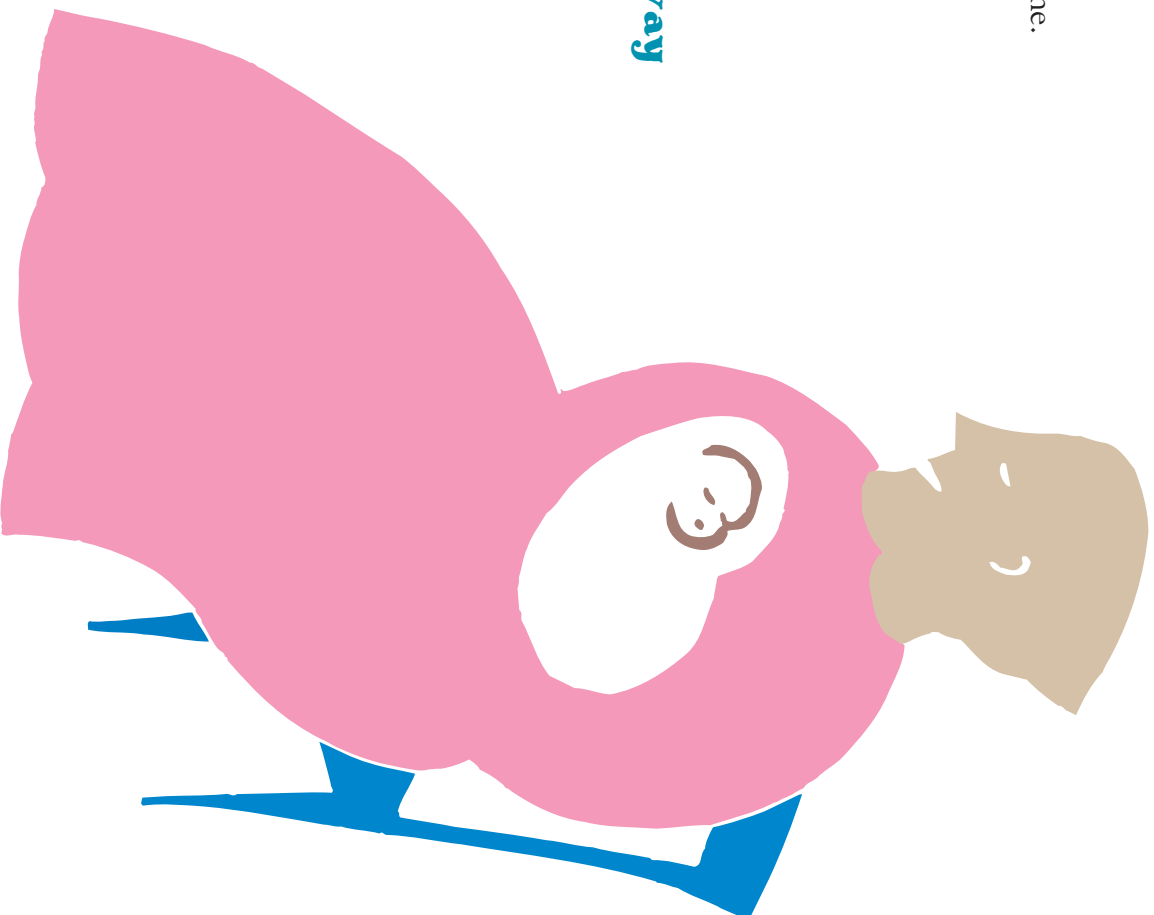
dodo, and let us go dreaming,

*tap bottom of baby's foot*

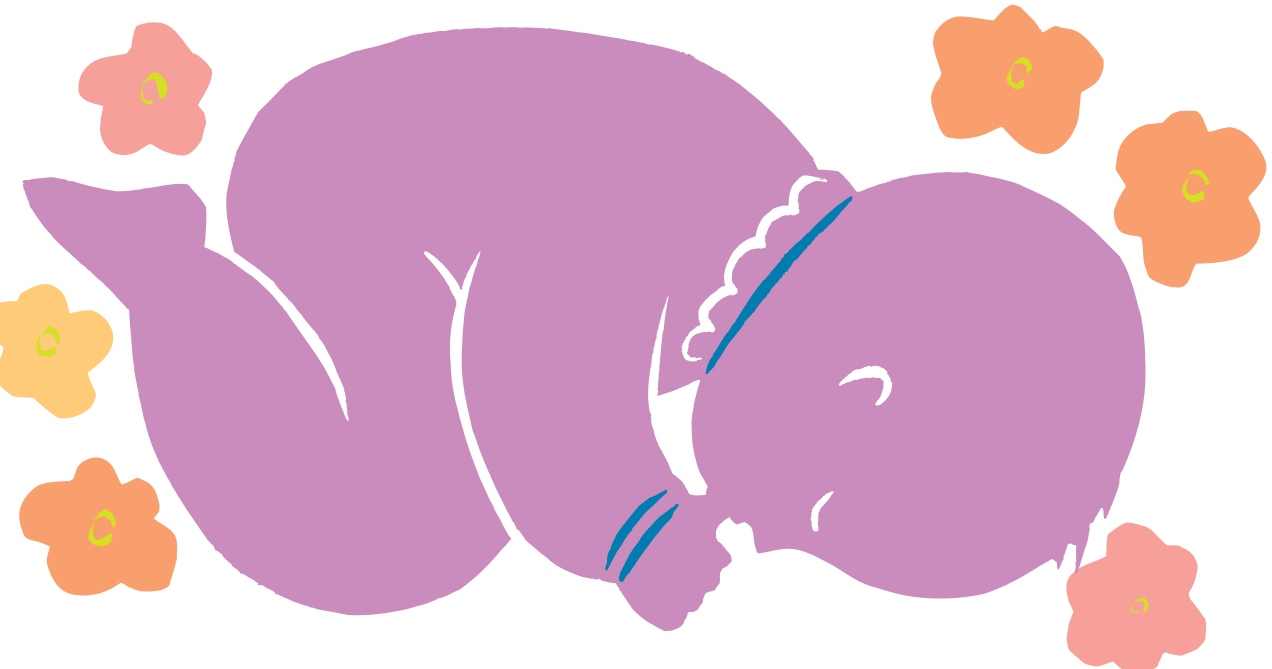
Shoe the old horse

## 41. Fire! Fire!

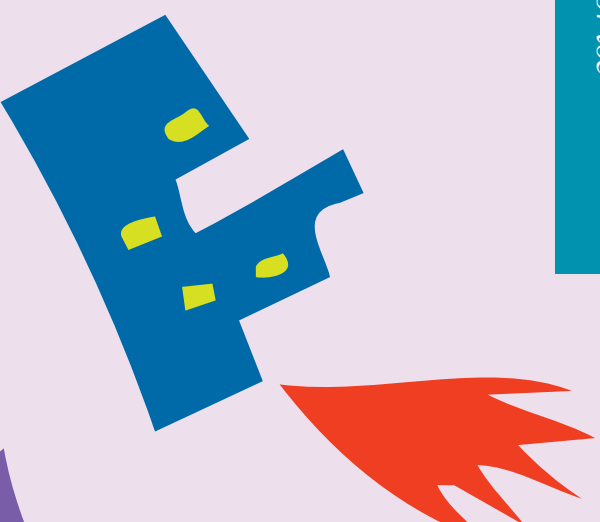
"Fire! Fire!" said Mrs. Dyer.

## 49. Shear the Sheep

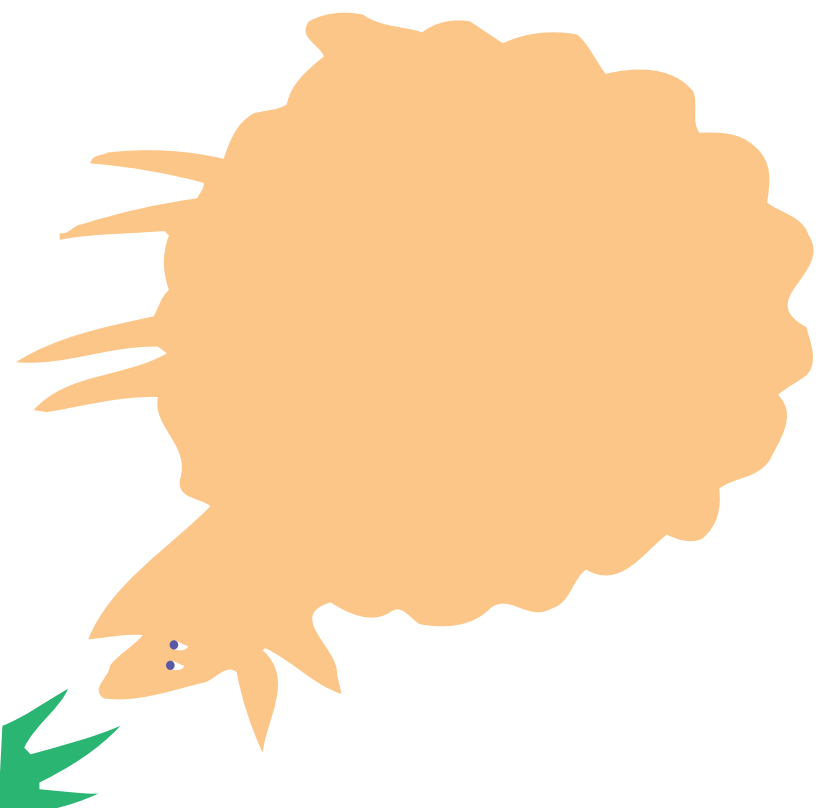
Shear the sheep and trim the tree,
