Missions Week is an opportunity for us at CCNYC to take some extra time to think about and pray for gospel mission work around the world. Beginning November 4, we hope you will use this week to begin reading and listening to some of the recommended resources below. We also hope you will use this opportunity to learn more about our global mission partners – Anna Warren in Uganda with Serge Ministries, as well as the George Whitefield College (GWC) in South Africa. Most of all, we hope you will spend some extra time praying for missionaries and missions work around the world. Parents, if you have children, use this week to emphasize to them the importance of global missions.

Concluding the week on November 11, Stephen Rockwell, who is a professor at the George Whitefield College, will be with us at Christ Church to help us think through missions and to update us about some of the good work that GWC is doing throughout Africa.

Use each day this week to pray for a different region of the world. For each region pray specifically for missionaries and unreached people groups in that region.
