Review of 1st to 3rd Person VTA

Unlike English, there are unique conjugations for each possible combination of subjects and objects. Here is the 1st to 3rd singular and plural conjugations:

```
Ni – waabam – aa.
I see her/him.
```

```
Ni – waabam – aag.
I see them.
```

2nd person to 3rd person Singular

Formula for conjugating 2nd person to 3rd person singular:

- Gi<u>waabam</u>aa.
- Giganawenimaa.
- Gi<u>wiidookawaa</u>.

You see him/her.

You take care of him/her.

You help him/her.

2nd person to 3rd person Plural

Formula for conjugating 2nd person to 3rd person plural:

- Gi<u>waabam</u>aag.
- Giganawenimaag.
- Giwiidookawaag.

You see them.

You take care of them.

You help them.

Ginoondawaa na noodin?

Correct or incorrect?

Incorrect. Noodin is inanimate.

Ninganawenimaag makwa aakozid.

Correct or incorrect?

Incorrect. The VTA is plural and the object is singular (makwa).

Ingii-miigwechiwenimaa giizis zhebaa.

Correct or incorrect?

Correct. VTA is singular 1st to 3rd, and the object is animate.

giizis is animate.

zhebaa = this past morning

Gigii-noondawaa na nika zhebaa?

Did you hear the goose this morning?



Ginoondawaag ina nikag bimisewaad ishpiming? Do you hear the geese flying overhead?



Gigii-waabamaag ina nikag owe onaagoshig? Did you see the geese this evening?



Gigii-bizindawaa na Marvin gaagiigidod bijiinaago? Did you listen to Marvin speaking yesterday?

gaagiigido = s/he speaks



Gigii-noondawaag ina ma'iinganag dibikong? Did you hear the wolves last night?



Gigii-miigwechiwenimaa na ma'iingan bemosed noongom? Were you thankful for the wolf walking by today?



Gigii-ganawenimaag ina asiniig? Did you take care of the rocks?



Gigii-gagwejimaag ina manidoog dabwaa-manoominikeyan?

Did you ask the spirits before you harvested wild rice?

dabwaa = before

Gigii-anokiitawaa ina Marvin biboonong? Did you work for Marvin last winter?

biboon = winter biboong = in the winter biboonong = last winter



Giga-bizindawaag ina ma'iinganag owe onaagoshig? Are you going to listen to the wolves this evening?

Gigii-wiisodemaa ina Josephine-iban apii bemosed giiwitaagaam gichigamiing?

Did you walk with Josephine when she walked around Lake Superior?

apii = when

giiwitaagaam = around the lake



Gigii-minwenimaa ina miskomini-biitoosijigan? Did you like the raspberry pie?



Gigii-ozhi'aag ina ingiw aagimag? Did you make those snowshoes?

ingiw = those



Nahaaw. Mii'iwe.

Gagwejim ina?
