Abraham is Declared Righteous Through Faith. (Romans 4:1-15)

- 1. Not justified by works, righteous through faith.
- 2. A distinction made between grace and works.
- 3. David and the blessedness of justification through faith. (see also Ps 32:1; 85:2; Isa 44:22; 43:25; 1:18; Micah 7:18-19)
- 4. Abraham counted righteous before he was circumcised.
- 5. God's promise to Abraham was based on the principle of faith, not law or works.

Following Abraham's Example (Romans 4:16-25)

- 1. Justification according to grace, through faith.
- 2. The life-giving power of God.
- 3. The character of Abraham's faith.
- 4. Abraham's justification and our own.
