


Recipe for Pleasure & Enjoyment



Serving: Consume immediately and do not package for another meal. Dish does not keep regardless if chilled or frozen. Always make fresh.






The Stillness

Did you know humans can echolocate?

There's even a wikipedia article on it. A blind man named Daniel Kish has been echolocating since he was a kid. He makes clicking sounds kinda like when drag queens do a mouth pop - and he can tell where things are. He calls it an "acoustic flashlight" and is teaching other blind people how to learn to echolocate.

This is for real, they've done a bunch of studies on people who use "human sonar" - and found it activates the visual part of the brain. Apparently, it creates a fuzzy 3d map of their environment, with the density and texture of an object being almost like "color". It's not super common or well studied, but Kish thinks that's because of social stigma around acting "weird" as a blind person and going around making funny sounds - and society not really valuing the freedom of disabled people to be independent. He credits his parents for just treating him like a normal kid most of the time, allowing him to explore his environment on his own, which led him to discover his echolocating ability.

As a sighted person I have tried closing my eyes and clicking and I will save you dear reader the embarrassment - you probably won't notice anything. But maybe you could learn?
