

## The rules

Only entries via the online registration service will be accepted. Entrants must report to the BT Games organiser 20 minutes before the above scheduled start times to confirm your attendance.

No shows on either day: contestants will be disqualified if absent. The judge reserves the right to allow runner-up entrants to fill the place of registered entrants who do not show up for a qualifier round or to allow walk-in entrants to fill contestant slots.

No bumping other contestants or interrupting or distracting them in any way. Only clean laps will be allowed and will count – any “dirty” lap will not count and will result in disqualification (such laps are usually indicated by an exclamation mark, brought about by leaving the track or colliding with another vehicle or barrier). You must use the given equipment to participate – no own equipment may be used. The judge has the right to change or add any rules at any time and without prior notice to entrants, and any choices made during the competition process will be upheld and no investigations will be entertained.

Each entrant’s time trial session will be made up of 3 laps – an outlap and two full laps. The fastest of the 3 will be the lap time considered, or the fastest of all clean laps.
