GAME NOTES

- **TWO FOR YOU:** The IceHogs have limited the Wolves to two or fewer goals in five of the last six games. That stretch includes five consecutive games with two or fewer goals before Chicago snapped the streak in the season finale of last year's series (5-2 CHI win on March 31).
- **ROOKIE MOVE:** Eleven different rookies have skated with the IceHogs through the first three games of the 2019-20 season. The IceHogs' 11 rookies are more than any other AHL team entering Friday. Overall, six teams in the AHL have featured eight or more rookies, and four of those six teams are in the Central Division.
- **THE REAL DEAL-IA:** Collin Delia made a season-high 40 saves Monday against the Rocket. The effort finished just six shy of his career-high 46 saves from the 2017-18 season against Manitoba (Feb. 2). Delia has now made 35+ saves in 12 different games for the IceHogs during his AHL career.
- **DRAFT KINGS:** With the addition of Kirby Dach, the IceHogs currently boast four first-round picks on their roster: Kirby Dach (3rd overall, CHI, 2019), Adam Boqvist (8th overall, CHI, 2018), Nicolas Beaudin (27th overall, CHI, 2018) and John Quenneville (30th overall, NJD, 2014).
- **SHOTS FIRED:** The Hogs outshot the Wolves in just one of 12 meetings during the 2018-19 series. Overall, Rockford was outshot 413-327 (-86) in the 12-game series last year.
- **TODAY'S PROMOTION:** The first 2,500 fans will receive a free Hogs magnet schedule, courtesy of American Solutions for Business.
