GAME NOTES

- **TWO FOR YOU:** The IceHogs have limited the Wolves to two or fewer goals in eight of the last 10 games. That stretch includes two of three games this season after Chicago tallied four markers in its 7-4 loss to the Hogs in the most recent meeting of the series on Nov. 3.
- **THREE-PEAT FEAT:** Rockford has opened the series with Chicago with three consecutive victories for the first time in team history. The IceHogs now enter Sunday's game with a chance to match the franchise's longest win streak overall against Chicago.
- **SHOOT YOUR SHOT:** The IceHogs scored seven goals on just 23 shots during the most recent meeting against the Wolves and capped their overtime win on Oct. 19 with two goals on 16 shots through the third period and OT. Combined, Rockford is shooting 23.1 percent against the Wolves over the last five periods of play in the series.
- EVERY ROSE(MONT) HAS ITS THORN: Rockford is seeking its second straight road win in the series with Chicago after defeating the Wolves 3-2 in OT on Oct. 19 at Allstate Arena. With that win, the Ice-Hogs now enter Sunday with points in six of the last seven road games against the Wolves and a 5-1-1-0 clip over that span
- **COMEBACK KIDS:** The Rockford IceHogs have trailed in each of their last four wins before ultimately mounting a comeback. That stretch includes victories against San Antonio (trailed 1-0), Iowa (trailed 2-0), Chicago (trailed 3-0) and Toronto (trailed 1-0). Rockford has won four of its last five games and six of the last nine contests since Oct. 18.

Sikura led the charge for the IceHogs in their comeback victory over the Wolves on Nov. 3. His third-period hat trick was the first of his career and pushed the forward to the top of the roster in both goals and points.



Nilsson has contributed a goal and an assist in three contests against the Wolves this season. In his career, the forward has scored 10 points (4g, 6a) through 12 games.



The Chicago Wolves enter Sunday tied with the San Antonio Rampage for third place in the Central Division. Chicago notched points in six straight games from Oct. 19 - Nov. 2, but snapped the streak with a loss to the IceHogs in the teams' most recent meeting on Nov. 3. Since that contest, the Wolves have dropped three of their last four games. Elvenes' 20 points is good for second in the AHL and his 15 assists lead the league. The rookie is in the midst of an 11-game point streak in which he's amassed 16 points with four goals and 12 assists.
