GAME NOTES

- **TWO FOR YOU:** The IceHogs have limited the Wolves to two or fewer goals in seven of the last eight games. That stretch includes each of the first two games this season in which Rockford defeated Chicago 3-2 on both Oct. 18 and Oct. 19.
- **THREE-PEAT FEAT:** Rockford opened the 2019-20 series with Chicago with back-to-back victories. The IceHogs enter Sunday seeking to start the series with three straight wins for the first time in team history.
- **THE REAL DEAL-IA:** Collin Delia stopped 29 of 31 shots to earn the win against Chicago on Oct. 18. He has now combined to stop 61 of 64 shots over his last two appearances against the Wolves, going 2-0-0 with a 1.45 GAA and .953 save percentage in that span.
- **SIK 'EM:** Tyler Sikura has scored in four of the last five games and has five total goals over that span. His five goals since Oct. 19 are tied for the most in the AHL in that span. Sikura enters Sunday's game ranked first on the team with both his five goals and six total points.
- **BIG LEAGUE BOQVIST:** Adam Boqvist was recalled by the Chicago Blackhawks on Thursday and made his NHL debut last night against the Los Angeles Kings. Boqvist is now the 117th former IceHogs skater to play in the NHL and 86th former Hog to skate with the Blackhawks.
- **TODAY'S PROMOTION:** Sunday's contest is the third Illinois Lottery Cup Series matchup of the 2019-20 season. The game also features a family ticket plan in which fans can purchase four tickets, four sodas and one large pizza from Papa John's for just \$44. In addition, fans can take the ice following the game for a Postgame Skate with the Hogs.

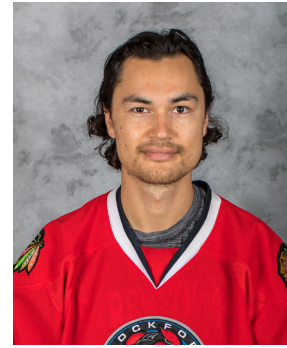
