GAME NOTES

- ON THE ROAD AGAIN: The Rockford IceHogs head to Canada for a two-game mini-series against the Manitoba Moose this week in need of points. However, the last time the IceHogs defeated the Moose in back-to-back contests at Bell MTS Iceplex was from March 26-28 of 2018. Since that pair of wins, Rockford is 0-3-1-0 when visiting Manitoba.
- THE RIGHT TRACK: After going 0-for-14 on the power play across five games from Jan. 15-22 and falling to 31st in the AHL in power play rankings, the Hogs have now netted eight power-play goals across their last seven matchups, going 8-for-34 (23.5%) in that span and jumping to 29th in the league with a success rate of 12.4% on the season.
- **GOALS GALORE:** After only scoring three goals in a game twice from Dec. 21-Jan. 22, the IceHogs have now notched more than two goals in a game four times in their last seven outings, including three goals in Friday's 3-2 overtime win versus the San Antonio Rampage.
- **BACK AT IT AGAIN:** Entering this week's mini-series with the Moose, the Hogs have 10 sets of back-to-back games in the final two and a half months of the season, including three instances in which the team plays three games in three days. So far in 2019-20, Rockford is 7-5-0-2 in the first half of back-to-backs and 6-7-1-0 in the back half.
- **DYL PICKLE:** Dylan Sikura dished an assist in Saturday's win over the San Antonio Rampage to increase his point streak to a career-high seven games in which he's deposited three goals and tossed seven assists. Not only is the streak the longest by any IceHog this season, but the stretch eclipses Sikura's previous career-high six-game point streak he set from Feb. 2-April 4 of 2019.
