GAME NOTES

- QUIETING THE RAMPAGE: The Rockford IceHogs look for revenge against the San Antonio Rampage after the latter defeated the former 3-2 in regulation during the last meeting between the two clubs on Nov. 26. Only one time since Nov. 11-12 of 2010 has Rockford lost two consecutive games against San Antonio in regulation. That sole instance came on Jan. 12-15 of 2019, and now the IceHogs look to avoid dropping their second straight contest in regulation to their divisional rival.
- A TALE OF TWO SEASONS: From the IceHogs' season-opener on Oct. 4 through Dec. 20, the IceHogs held an overall record of 17-10-0-1 and reached as high as second place in the Central Division. However, since Dec. 21, Rockford has won just four matchups, going 4-14-1-1 in that span and falling to sixth place in the Central.
- MAKE IT COUNT: The IceHogs sat dead last in the AHL with a power-play rate of 10.3% after going five straight games without a goal on the man-advantage from Jan. 15-Jan. 22. However, Rockford is now 6-for-22 (27.3%) with the extra man across their last five and has jumped to 29th in the league with an 12.2% success rate on the season.
- **DYL PICKLE:** Dylan Sikura netted a goal and dished an assist Tuesday to increase his point streak to five games in which he's deposited eight points (3g, 5a). The streak sets the club's season-long point streak and Sikura is now just one game shy of tying a career-high six-game point streak he set from Feb. 2-April 4 of 2019 in which he contributed seven points (3g, 4a).


