GAME NOTES

- GOALS GALORE: After only scoring three goals in a game twice from Dec. 21-Jan. 22, the IceHogs have now notched more than two goals in a game four times in their last six outings, including three goals in last night's 3-2 overtime win versus the San Antonio Rampage. However, Rockford has surrendered at least three goals in four of their last six and 13 of their last 21.
- **DYL PICKLE:** Dylan Sikura dished an assist in last night's win over the Rampage to increase his point streak to six games in which he's deposited nine points (3g, 6a). The streak sets the club's season-long point streak and Sikura is now just one game shy of eclipsing the career-high six-game point streak he set from Feb. 2-April 4 of 2019 in which he contributed seven points (3g, 4a).
- **BACK-TO-BACK:** After this weekend, the IceHogs have 10 sets of back-to-back games in the final two and a half months of the season, including three instances in which the team plays three games in three days. So far in 2019-20, Rockford is 7-6-0-2 in the first half of back-to-backs and 6-6-1-0 in the back half of back-to-backs.
- A TALE OF TWO SEASONS: From the IceHogs' season-opener on Oct. 4 through Dec. 20, the IceHogs held an overall record of 17-10-0-1 and reached as high as second place in the Central Division. However, since Dec. 21, Rockford has won just five matchups, going 5-14-1-1 in that span and falling to sixth place in the Central.
- **TODAY'S PROMOTION:** The first 1,500 fans Saturday will receive a sock monkey bobblehead courtesy of Midway Village Museum. Fans can donate a new pair of socks for free tickets to the game on Feb. 21.
