## GAME NOTES

- **WE ARE THE CAPTAINS NOW:** The IceHogs dropped their first visit to the UW Panther Arena during the 2019-20 season on Friday by a score of 2-0. However, Rockford matched the franchise's all-time road win total against the Admirals in a single series last year with a record of 4-1-0-1 at UW Panther Arena.
- **REBOUND BRANDON:** Brandon Hagel was held pointless in Friday's loss at Milwaukee, but in 29 games since Oct. 30, there have only been two instances in which Hagel has not rebounded from a pointless performance to find the scoresheet the very next game. He's been held pointless 12 times in that span but has tallied a combined 12 points (7g, 5a) in subsequent efforts.
- **LUCKY 13:** The IceHogs have featured 13 different skaters to score at least one goal over the last 11 games (since Dec. 15). Those 13 skaters have combined for 26 total goals in that span with eight players scoring multiple goals and five with a lone tally. The group includes nine forwards and four defensemen, as well as four AHL rookies.
- **SIK 'EM:** Tyler Sikura's minus-2 rating in Friday's loss marked just the second time in his last 20 games that he failed to register an even-or-better plus/minus rating. Sikura's plus-8 rating on the season ranks second on the active IceHogs roster behind Lucas Carlsson (+9).
- **RARE AIR:** Wednesday's loss at Milwaukee extended Rockford's road losing streak to four games. It's the longest road losing streak of the season and marks the first time the IceHogs have lost four consecutive games on the road since the club lost five straight from Jan. 20 - Feb. 23 of 2018.

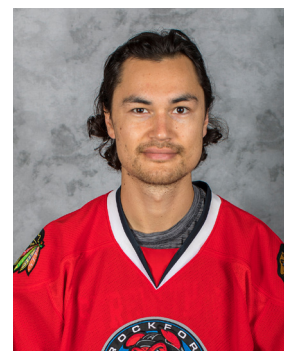
