## GAME NOTES

- **WOAH! WE'RE HALFWAY THERE:** The IceHogs officially hit the halfway point of the season with game number 38 last night when they lost 4-1 to Milwaukee. They enter Wednesday's contest against the Griffins in a three-way tie for fourth in the Central Division with 38 points and a record of 18-18-1-1. The IceHogs hold a 3-2-0-0 record against the Griffins halfway through the clubs' 10 total matchups in 2019-20.
- **THREE'S COMPANY:** Five separate Hogs skaters share the team lead for most points against the Griffins this season. MacKenzie Entwistle, Philipp Kurashev, Lucas Carlsson, Jacob Nilsson and Tyler Sikura all share the lead with three. Meanwhile, Carlsson and Sikura share the team lead in career points against Grand Rapids with 11 each. Carlsson has compiled two goals and nine assists through 14 career games while Sikura has tallied one goal and 10 assists in 22 matchups.
- **HOLY JUMPING, JACOB:** Since Jan. 5, Jacob Nilsson has compiled six points (2g, 4a) in five games. In that span, he leads the Rockford roster in assists and points and is tied for the lead in goals as well. Additionally, of all IceHogs to have contributed a point since Jan. 5, he is the only skater to register a positive plus/minus rating. Nilsson is a +1 since that date while the other nine point scorers are a combined -4.
- **REBOUND BRANDON:** Brandon Hagel was held pointless in Tuesday night's loss, but in 31 games since Oct. 30, there have only been two instances in which Hagel has not rebounded from a pointless performance to find the scoresheet the very next game. Hagel has been held pointless 13 times in that span but has tallied a combined 13 points (7g, 6a) in subsequent efforts.
