## GAME NOTES

- **GRYFFIN-DOWN:** With their shootout win Wednesday, Rockford increased its lead in the season series against the Grand Rapids Griffins to 4-2-0-0 through six of the two teams' 10 total matchups. The Hogs have won the season series in each of the last two seasons, going 7-3-0-0 against the Griffins in 2018-19 and 6-3-1-0 against the club in 2017-18.
- **THREE FOR ME:** The IceHogs have only managed to score three goals in a game twice in the last 11 contests. The club holds a record of 16-1-0-1 record when scoring more than two goals this year and are 3-17-1-0 when tallying two or fewer goals. Dating to last season, the Hogs are 46-3-1-2 when scoring more than two goals.
- **HOLY JUMPING, JACOB:** Since Jan. 5, Jacob Nilsson has compiled six points (2g, 4a) in six appearances. In that span, he leads the entire Rockford roster in assists and points and is tied for the team-lead in goals as well. Of all IceHogs to have contributed a point since Jan. 5, he is the only skater to register a positive plus/minus rating. Nilsson is a +1 since that date while the other 11 point scorers are a combined -7.
- **FEELS LIKE THE FIRST TIME:** Chad Kryszewski netted his first professional goal when he scored the game-tying goal late in the third period of Wednesday's shootout win. With the marker, he is now the 11th skater this season to net his first AHL goal as a member of the IceHogs.
- **SIK 'EM:** Tyler Sikura registered an even plus/minus rating in Wednesday's win over Grand Rapids to continue his trend of even-or-better plus/minus ratings. Just two times in his last 23 games has Sikura failed to register an even-or-better plus/minus rating. Sikura's plus-8 rating on the season ranks tied for second on the IceHogs roster.

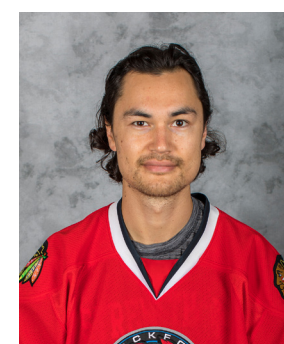
