GAME NOTES

- **TWO FOR YOU:** The IceHogs have limited the Wolves to two or fewer goals in 10 of the last 12 games. That stretch includes four of five games this season after the Hogs held Chicago to one goal in the most recent meeting of the series on Nov. 29 (4-2 win).
- 3 FOR ME: Rockford has scored at least three goals in each of the first five meetings of the season series against the Wolves after accomplishing the feat in just five of 12 total meetings last season. The IceHogs are outscoring the Wolves 21-11 entering Sunday's game, and the 21 total goals scored against Chicago is seven more than Rockford's goal total against any opponent in 2019-20.
- HI-5: Rockford has opened the series with Chicago with five consecutive victories for the first time in team history. The five-game win streak is also the team's overall longest win streak against the Wolves in team history, surpassing the previous record of four straight victories against Chicago from Nov. 20 Dec. 27, 2009. Rockford's five-game streak is the fifth-longest win streak against any AHL opponent in team history.
- **SUNDAY FUNDAY:** The IceHogs have won four of five Sunday games (4-1-0-0) this season, opening the season with four consecutive Sunday wins before snapping the streak with a 3-2 loss at Manitoba last Sunday. Rockford also posted its best win percentage of any day of the week during the 2018-19 season on Sunday (8-3-1-1) and enters today's matchup with a 12-4-1-1 clip on Sunday over the last two seasons.
- **TODAY'S PROMOTION:** The first 2,500 fans get a free pack of Ice-Hogs team cards, courtesy of Gizmo's Sportscards. After the game, fans can join the players for a skate on the BMO Harris Bank Center ice.


