## GAME NOTES

- **NIGHTMARE ON ELM STREET:** The IceHogs have won 11 of the last 13 home games against the Grand Rapids Griffins dating back to the final meeting of the 2016-17 series. Further, the IceHogs have posted .500-or-better record at home in 11 of 12 seasons against the Griffins.
- **THREE FOR ME:** Jacob Nilsson leads the IceHogs in scoring against the Griffins this season with three points (3a) in three games. The forward has tallied an assist in each of the first three games of the series and has notched each of those helpers as primary assists.
- **HOT HOGS:** The IceHogs have won eight of their last 12 games and boast points in nine of those 12 contests dating to Oct. 30. That stretch also includes notching points in back-to-back road games for the first time this season following a SOL at Texas and OTW at San Antonio.
- **DYLAN'S DAGGERS:** Dylan Sikura scored the game-winning goal last night and has now netted nearly one third of his total AHL goals as game-winners. He enters Saturday having potted eight of his 25 goals as game-winning tallies (32%).
- **SIKURA SQUARED:** Dylan and Tyler Sikura each tallied a point in last night's win and share the team lead with each other in scoring. They have eight goals and five assists apiece and have each assisted on two of each other's goals on the year. The duo has combined to produce 16 of Rockford's 57 goals (28%).
- **TONIGHT'S PROMOTION:** Warm up from the cold at Stroll on State with a mittens giveaway and hot chocolate bar inside the BMO. Fans can also partake in a holiday karaoke competition.

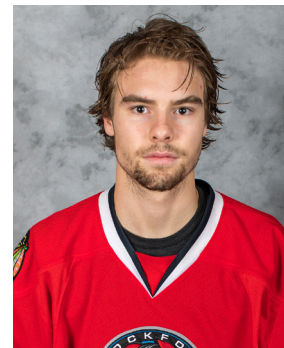
