GAME NOTES

- **HOME AWAY FROM HOME:** The road team has won 11 of the last 16 games during the regular season in the series between Rockford and Manitoba. In overall wins and losses, the IceHogs are 5-3 on the road against Manitoba over that stretch and the Moose are 6-2 in Rockford.
- **COMEBACK KIDS:** The Rockford IceHogs have trailed in each of their last four games before ultimately mounting a comeback to beat San Antonio, Iowa, Chicago and Toronto. Rockford has now won four consecutive games and six of its last eight contests dating to Oct. 18.
- **HOME IS WHERE THE HOG IS:** Rockford extended its home winning streak to five games and now has the second-longest active home winning streak in the AHL behind Hartford (six games). The Hogs have scored 3+ goals in each of their last five home games and their 25 total goals at home rank second in the Western Conference (Milwaukee, 27).
- **GIANT KILLERS:** Rockford has defeated division leaders in two of its last three games. The IceHogs defeated the Wild last Saturday when Iowa was ranked first in the Central Division and Toronto on Wednesday with the Marlies ranked first in the North Division.
- **STARTED FROM THE BOTTOM:** After beginning the season 0-for-28 on the power play, the IceHogs have netted four power-play goals over the last four games and are 4-for-20 (20.0%) with the man-advantage over that stretch.
- **TODAY'S PROMOTION:** The Hogs cap a five-game homestand with \$2 beer night at the BMO Harris Bank Center. Budweiser and Bud Light beer will be available for just \$2 at most concessions on the concourse.

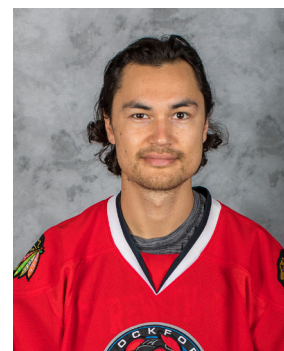

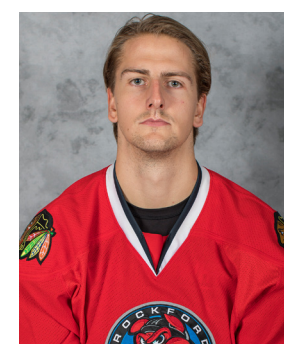
