GAME NOTES

- **TONIGHT I BOUNCE BACK:** After dropping the last contest between the two clubs 3-2 on Feb. 8, the Rockford IceHogs enter Friday's matchup at risk of losing back-to-back games to the San Antonio Rampage in regulation for just the second time since Nov. 11-12 of 2010. The only other instance came on Jan. 12-15 of 2019 when the Hogs fell to the Rampage 4-3 on Jan. 12 and 2-1 on Jan. 15.
- **LUC-ING GOOD:** Lucas Carlsson buried his first goal since Jan. 11 in Tuesday's loss to the Griffins to extend his point streak to seven games in which he's scored once and set up eight goals. The stretch marks the longest point streak of his professional career and ties the longest point streak by any IceHogs defenseman in American Hockey League history. Adam Clendening previously set the record when he also notched a goal and eight assists across seven games from Feb. 24-March 15, 2013. With the stretch, Carlsson now leads the entire Rockford roster in assists with 21.
- **MAKE IT COUNT:** After going 0-for-14 on the power play across five games from Jan. 15-22 and falling to 31st in the AHL in power play rankings, the IceHogs have now netted 10 power-play goals across their last 11 matchups, going 10-for-47 (21.3%) in that span and jumping to 29th in the league with a success rate of 12.6% on the season.
- **DYL PICKLE:** Dylan Sikura's assist in Tuesday's loss to the Griffins increases his point streak to a career-high 11 games in which he's deposited four goals and tossed 10 assists. The last time a member of the IceHogs bagged points in 11 straight contests was Feb. 1-March 4 of 2014 when Jeremy Morin compiled 20 points (11g, 9a) across a 13-game streak.

The IceHogs are only two points out of playoff position behind the Chicago Wolves, who have 55 points.
