## GAME NOTES

- **FANTASTIC FOUR:** Since the IceHogs' current stretch in which they've won six of their last eight games dating to Feb. 4, the club has been led offensively by four skaters. In that span, Lucas Carlsson (1-8-9), John Quenneville (4-1-5), Dylan Sikura (2-6-8) and Tyler Sikura (1-4-5) have combined for eight goals, 19 assists and 27 points.
- **GOTTA GET ON THE GOOD FOOT:** The IceHogs defeated the San Antonio Rampage on Friday after taking a lead into the first intermission. Rockford boasts a record of 9-3-1-0 this season when leading after the opening frame but is just 9-11-0-2 when tied after one and 7-12-0-0 when trailing after one for a combined 16-23-0-2 when entering the first intermission tied or trailing.
- **MAKE IT COUNT:** After going 0-for-14 on the power play across five games from Jan. 15-22 and falling to 31st in the AHL in power play rankings, the IceHogs have now netted 10 power-play goals across their last 12 matchups, going 10-for-49 (20.4%) in that span and jumping to 29th in the league with a success rate of 12.5% on the season. Additionally, the IceHogs have bagged five goals on the man-advantage in the last four games against the Ads, who possess the fourth-ranked penalty kill in the league (85.8%).
- **TURNING AROUND THE TURNAROUND:** From the season-opener on Oct. 4 through Dec. 20, the IceHogs held a record of 17-10-0-1 and reached as high as second place in the Central Division. However, from Dec. 21 through Feb. 1, Rockford fell to sixth place in the division. But now, the Hogs have won six of their last eight games since Feb. 4 and have climbed into a tie for fourth in the Central alongside the Chicago Wolves for the final playoff spot.

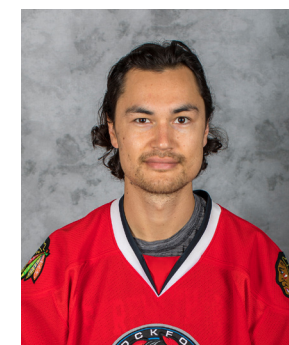
