PREFACE

AS ROMAN CATHOLICS, we are privileged to benefit from the cumulative treasure of our faith expressed as profound ritual and prayer, timeless Scripture and exquisite sacred music. All are both formative and professive (*lex credendi*, *lex orandi*; *lex orandi*, *lex credendi*). Still, the most powerful confession and the most efficacious, even formative grace can arguably be experienced through compelling hymns, songs, psalms and service music.

Throughout the centuries, each generation has contributed to the storehouse of time-honored, faithful sacred music and texts. At times, we have experimented with trite and fleeting works, often directed to one another rather than to God. But, art that endures and sung prayer that elevates our minds, our hearts, and our souls into a true experience of our loving God is never about us. Augustine of Hippo reminds us always that everything in our lives ought to be praise of God, and if our prayer does not direct us to Him, how then could our lives?

Hymnal 2022 is the finest collection of hymns and songs directed to God. In this hymnal, there is no tampering with the language of God, the persons of the Trinity, or the masculine pronouns that refer to Father, Son and Holy Spirit. There is no attempt at homogenization, the blurring of lines between Catholic and other Christian traditions as well as non-Christian religions in the pretense of unity. There is no confusion of doctrine. There is no attempt to be all things to everyone, for when we do so, in the end we are nothing. For the sake of both clarity and respect, all divine pronouns are capitalized; we always know to Whom we are singing. Lastly, the hymns are about and in praise of God, not us, and are never fluff or "in the moment."

The year 2020 was perhaps the most challenging of our lives. We have suffered through restrictive circumstances to protect our health and familial well-being. We have even lost loved ones unexpectedly and abruptly. Yet, as often happens, strife can bring with it the fruit of goodness. In this year, we rediscovered that which brings the greatest lasting value to our lives. In this year, we renewed our spousal and familial love through increased time together and the gift of shared experiences that might not have been. And in this year, *Hymnal 2022* began.

2020 brought us clarity of vision; and, following two years of careful crafting, *Hymnal 2022* now celebrates the sacred music that brings true fidelity to our prayer and to our lives. It is the only hymnal in the United States that completely honors the guidelines of the document *Sacred Music at the Service of the Church* authored by the Doctrine Committee of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops.

May it improve our lives, enrich our faith, and invigorate our Baptism in the days and years before us. Through this book and our singing of the great works within it, may our children and their children know the legacy of our believing, without compromise.

INTRODUCTORY RITES


All stand. When the people are gathered, the Priest approaches the altar with the ministers while the Entrance Chant is sung.

When the Entrance Chant is concluded, the Priest and the faithful, standing, sign themselves with the Sign of the Cross, while the Priest, facing the people, says:

In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

As Catholics, we fully participate in the celebration of the Eucharist when we receive Holy Communion. We are encouraged to receive Communion devoutly and frequently. In order to be properly disposed to receive Communion, participants should not be conscious of grave sin and normally should have fasted for one hour. A person who is conscious of grave sin is not to receive the Body and Blood of the Lord without prior sacramental confession except for a grave reason where there is no opportunity for confession. In this case, the person is to be mindful of the obligation to make an act of perfect contrition, including the intention of confessing as soon as possible (Code of Canon Law, canon 916). A frequent reception of the Sacrament of Penance is encouraged for all.

For Other Christians

We welcome our fellow Christians to this celebration of the Eucharist as our brothers and sisters. We pray that our common baptism and the action of the Holy Spirit in this Eucharist will draw us closer to one another and begin to dispel the sad divisions which separate us. We pray that these will lessen and finally disappear, in keeping with Christ's prayer for us "that they may all be one" (In 17:21).

Because Catholics believe that the celebration of the Eucharist is a sign of the reality of the oneness of faith, life, and worship, members of those churches with whom we are not yet fully united are ordinarily not admitted to Holy Communion. Eucharistic sharing in exceptional circumstances by other Christians requires permission according to the directives of the diocesan bishop and the provisions of canon law (canon 844 § 4). Members of the Orthodox Churches, the Assyrian Church of the East, and the Polish National Catholic Church are urged to respect the discipline of their own Churches. According to Roman Catholic discipline, the Code of Canon Law does not object to the reception of communion by Christians of these Churches (canon 844 § 3).

For Those Not Receiving Communion

All who are not receiving Holy Communion are encouraged to express in their hearts a prayerful desire for unity with the Lord Jesus and with one another.

For Non-Christians

We also welcome to this celebration those who do not share our faith in Jesus Christ. While we cannot admit them to Holy Communion, we ask them to offer their prayers for the peace and the unity of the human family.

Prayer of Self-Offering

Receive, Lord, my entire freedom. Accept the whole of my memory, my intellect and my will. Whatever I have or possess, it was you who gave it to me; I restore it to you in full, and I surrender it completely to the guidance of your will. Give me only love of you together with your grace, and I am rich enough and ask for nothing more. Amen.

Prayer to Our Lord Jesus Christ Crucified

Behold, O good and loving Jesus, that I cast myself on my knees before you and, with the greatest fervor of spirit, I pray and beseech you to instill into my heart, ardent sentiments of faith, hope and charity, with true repentance for my sins and a most firm purpose of amendment. With deep affection and sorrow I ponder intimately and contemplate in my mind your five wounds, having before my eyes what the prophet David had already put in your mouth about yourself, O good Jesus: They have pierced my hands and my feet; they have numbered all my bones (*Ps 21: 17–18*).

Anima Christi (Traditional Version)

Soul of Christ, sanctify me.
Body of Christ, save me.
Blood of Christ, inebriate me.
Water from Christ's side, wash me.
Passion of Christ, strengthen me.
O good Jesus, hear me.
Within Thy wounds hide me.
Suffer me not to be separated from Thee.

From the malicious enemy, defend me. In the hour of my death, call me; and bid me come unto Thee, that I may praise Thee with Thy saints and with Thy angels for ever and ever, Amen.

Prayer of Saint Bonaventure

Pierce, O most sweet Lord Jesus, my inmost soul with the most joyous and healthful wound of Thy love, and with true, calm and most holy apostolic charity, that my soul may ever languish and melt with entire love and longing for Thee, may yearn for Thee and for Thy courts, may long to be dissolved and to be with Thee.

Grant that my soul may hunger after Thee, the Bread of Angels, the refreshment of holy souls, our daily and super substantial bread, having all sweetness and savor and every delightful taste.

May my heart ever hunger after and feed upon Thee, Whom the angels desire to look upon, and may my inmost soul be filled with the sweetness of Thy savor; may it ever thirst for Thee, the fountain of life, the fountain of wisdom and knowledge, the fountain of eternal light, the torrent of pleasure, the fullness of the house of God; may it ever compass Thee, seek Thee, find Thee, run to Thee, come up to Thee, meditate on Thee, speak of Thee, and do all for the praise and glory of Thy name, with humility and discretion, with love and delight, with ease and affection, with perseverance to the end; and be Thou alone ever my hope, my entire confidence, my riches, my delight, my pleasure, my joy, my rest and tranquility, my peace, my sweetness, my food, my refreshment, my refuge, my help, my wisdom, my portion, my possession, my treasure; in Whom may my mind and my heart be ever fixed and firm and rooted immovably. Amen.

Prayer After Receiving Communion

O Lord Jesus Christ, who in this wonderful Sacrament hast left to us a memorial of Thy Passion: Grant us, we beseech Thee, so to venerate the sacred mysteries of Thy Body and Blood, that we may ever perceive within ourselves the fruit of Thy redemption; who livest and reignest with the Father and the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever. Amen.

FOR THOSE WHO CANNOT RECEIVE COMMUNION

An Act of Spiritual Communion

My Jesus,
I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament.
I love You above all things,
and I desire to receive You into my soul.
Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally,
come at least spiritually into my heart.
I embrace You as if You were already there

and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.

DAILY PRAYERS

My God, I offer You my prayers, works, joys, and sufferings of this day in union with the holy sacrifice of the Mass throughout the world. I offer them for all the intentions of Your Son's Sacred Heart, for the salvation of souls, reparation for sin, and the reunion of Christians. Amen.

Prayer to the Holy Spirit

- V Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of Your faithful.
- R/ And kindle in them the fire of Your love.
- R And You shall renew the face of the earth.

Let us pray:

O God, by the light of the Holy Spirit You have taught the hearts of Your faithful. In the same Spirit, help us to know what is truly right and always to rejoice in Your consolation. We ask this through Christ, our Lord. Amen.

Act of Faith

I believe these and all the truths which the Holy Catholic Church teaches, because You have revealed them, who can neither deceive nor be deceived. Amen.

Act of Hope

O my God, relying on Your infinite goodness and promises, I hope to obtain pardon of my sins, the help of Your grace, and life everlasting, through the merits of Jesus Christ, my Lord and Redeemer. Amen.

Act of Charity

O my God, I love You above all things, with my whole heart and soul, because You are all-good and worthy of all love. I love my neighbor as myself for the love of You. I forgive all who have injured me, and ask pardon of all whom I have injured. Amen.

Prayer to Saint Michael

Saint Michael the Archangel, defend us in battle; be our defense against the wickedness and snares of the devil. May God rebuke him, we humbly pray; and do thou, O prince of the heavenly host, by the power of God, cast into hell Satan and all the evil spirits who prowl about the world seeking the ruin of souls.
