


Seven Mile Road, we are immeasurably grateful to partner with you in this work, and we treasure the privilege to see God's mission go forth in our city and to the ends of the earth.

In light of the task remaining among the unreached, we've taken a focused approach—strategically investing in three telescoped regions where the Spirit has stirred our hearts: West Africa, North India, and now, Central Asia. Through deep, long-term partnerships in these regions, we have the privilege of supporting and witnessing the gospel's power to transform lives and communities across diverse cultures. Together, as one body, we labor faithfully to see God's kingdom advance among the lost and least.

This year also marked the end of a 5-year, \$1 Million Campaign to Redeemer City to City. City to City catalyzes gospel movements in cities worldwide by equipping and supporting leaders to plant and strengthen churches. Since we began this campaign five years ago, Seven Mile Road has given one million dollars to catalyze the church in West Africa and Northern India. What a joy it has been to partner with City to City as we together ask God to make His name known in all the earth!
