A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN EXEMPTION FROM AUDIT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2016
FOR THE WILEY RURAL FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT, State of Colorado.

WHEREAS, the Wiley Rural Fire Protection District wishes to claim exemption from the audit requirements of Section 29-1-603, C.R.S.; and

WHEREAS, Section 29-1-604, C.R.S. states that any local government where neither revenues nor expenditures exceed seven hundred and fifty thousand dollars may, with the approval of the state auditor, be exempt from the provision of Section 29-1-603, C.R.S.; and

WHEREAS, neither revenues nor expenditures for the Wiley Rural Fire Protection District exceeded \$750,000 for fiscal year 2016; and


WHEREAS, an application for exemption from audit for the Wiley Rural Fire Protection District has been prepared by Gary Anderson CPA, an independent accountant with knowledge of governmental accounting; and

WHEREAS, said application for exemption from audit has been completed in accordance with regulations issued by the State Auditor.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Wiley Rural Fire Protection District governing body that the application for exemption from audit for the Wiley Rural Fire Protection District for the fiscal year ended December 31, 2016, has been personally reviewed and is hereby approved by a majority of the Wiley Rural Fire Protection District governing body; that those members of the governing body have signified their approval by signing below; and that this resolution shall be attached to, and shall become a part of the application for exemption from audit of the Wiley Rural Fire Protection District for the fiscal year ended December 31, 2016.


