A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN EXEMPTION FROM AUDIT FOR FICAL YEAR 2016 FOR THE **BOOKCLIFF CONSERVATION DISTRICT**, STATE OF COLORADO,

WHEREAS, the **BOOKCLIFF CONSERVATION DISTRICT**, wishes to claim exemption from the audit requirements of Section 29-1-603, CRS; and

WHEREAS, the Section 29-1-604, CRS, states that any local government where neither revenues nor expenditures exceed five hundred thousand dollars may, with the approval of the State Auditor, be exempt from the provision of Section 29-1-603, CRS; and

WHEREAS, neither revenue nor expenditures for **BOOKCLIFF CONSERVATION DISTRICT** exceed \$100,000 for the fiscal year 2016; and

WHEREAS, an application for exemption from audit for the **BOOKCLIFF CONSERVATION DISTRICT** has been prepared by Sharie Prow, a person skilled in governmental accounting; and


WHEREAS, said application for exemption from audit has been completed in accordance with regulations, issued by the state auditor.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the **BOOKCLIFF CONSERVATION DISTRICT** that the application for exemption for audit for **BOOKCLIFF CONSERVATION DISTRICT** for the fiscal year ended December 31, 2016, has been personally reviewed and is hereby approved by a majority of the **BOOKCLIFF CONSERVATION DISTRICT**; that those members of the **BOOKCLIFF CONSERVATION DISTRICT** have signified their approval for signing below; and that that resolution shall be attached to, and shall become a part of the application for exemption from the audit of the **BOOKCLIFF CONSERVATION DISTRICT** for the fiscal year ended December, 2016.
