A RESOLUTION/ORDINANCE APPROVING AN EXEMPTION FROM AUDIT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015 FOR THE LA PLATA CONSERVATION DISTRICT, STATE OF COLORADO.

WHEREAS, the LPCD Board of the La Plata Conservation District wishes to claim exemption from the audit requirements of Section 29-1-603, C.R.S.; and

WHEREAS, Section 29-1-604, C.R.S., states that any local government where neither revenues nor expenditures exceed five hundred thousand dollars may, with the approval of the State Auditor, be exempt from the provision of Section 29-1-603, C.R.S.; and

WHEREAS, neither revenue nor expenditures for the La Plata Conservation District exceeded \$100,000 for Fiscal Year 2016; and

WHEREAS, an application for exemption from audit for the La Plata Conservation District has been prepared by David Miller, a person that has prepared prior audit exemptions; and


WHEREAS, said application for exemption from audit has been completed in accordance with regulations, issued by the State Auditor.






