Attached are the District's Audit Exemption for 2017, Debt Repayment Schedule and Other Expenditures.

Also, please note that the District's expenditures exceeded amounts budgeted and appropriated for 2017. This happened as the result of the Colorado Water Quality Control Division, Department of Public Health & Environment approving a pilot canister testing in July 2017 declaring our well water system, GWUDI (Ground Water under the Direct Influence). At that time, we applied for the Pursuing Excellence Award Grant to help defray the cost to begin the pilot testing. The District did receive the grant; however, it was only disbursed as deliverables were met. The District had to use funds not budgeted for, for the extra expenditures. I have attached a spreadsheet identifying the extra expense. We didn't know what the exact overages of the extra expenses were going to be, until the end of the year, beginning of 2018. That is why a Resolution to Change Budget has not been filed. Should I file a Resolution at this time?

Please let me know what needs to be filed at this point so that the District remains in good standing with all of its requirements for budget reporting.
