### Office of the State Auditor — Local Government Division - Exemption Form Electronic Signatures Policy and Procedure

#### Policy - Requirements

The Office of the State Auditor Local Government Audit Division may accept an electronic submission of an application for exemption from audit that includes governing board signatures obtained through a program such as DocuSign or EchoSign. Required elements and safeguards are as follows:

- The preparer of the application is responsible for obtaining board signatures that comply with the requirement in Section 29-1-604 (3), C.R.S., that states the application shall be personally reviewed, approved, and signed by a majority of the members of the governing body.
- The application must be accompanied by the signature history document created by the electronic signature software. The signature history document must show when the document was created and when the document was emailed to the various parties, and include the dates the individual board members signed the document. The signature history must also show the individuals' email addresses and IP address.
- Office of the State Auditor staff will not coordinate obtaining signatures.

**The application for exemption from audit form created by our office includes a section for governing body approval. Local governing boards note their approval and submit the application through one of the following three methods:**

- 1) Submit the application in hard copy via the US Mail including original signatures.
- 2) Submit the application electronically via email and either,
  - a. Include a copy of an adopted resolution that documents formal approval by the Board, **or**
  - b. Include electronic signatures obtained through a software program such as DocuSign or EchoSign in accordance with the requirements noted above.

WHEREAS, section 29-1-604, C.R.S., states that any local government where neither revenues nor expenditures exceed seven hundred and fifty thousand dollars may, with the approval of the State Auditor, be exempt from the provision of Section 29-1-603, C.R.S., and

WHEREAS, neither revenue nor expenditures for Teller-Park Conservation District exceeded \$100,000 for fiscal year 2017, and

WHEREAS, an application for exemption from audit for Teller-Park Conservation District has been prepared by Marisa Neuzil, a person skilled in government accounting and,

WHEREAS, said application for exemption from audit has been completed in accordance with regulations, issued by the State Auditor.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved/ordained by the Board of Supervisors of the Teller-Park Conservation District that the application for exemption from audit for Teller-Park Conservation District for the Fiscal Year ended December 31, 2017 has been personally reviewed and is hereby approved by a majority of the Board of supervisors of the Teller-Park Conservation District and those members of the Teller-Park Conservation District have signified their approval by signing below; and that this resolution shall be attached to , and shall become a part of , the application for exemption from audit of the Teller-Park Conservation District for the fiscal year ended December 31, 2017.


