RESOLUTION FOR EXEMPTION FROM AUDIT

(Pursuant to Section 29-1-604, C.R.S.)

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN EXEMPTION FROM AUDIT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018 FOR THE TOWN OF STARKVILLE, STATE OF COLORADO.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Starkville wishes to claim exemption from the audit requirements of Section 29-1-603, C.R.S.; and

WHEREAS, Section 29-1-604, C.R.S., states that any local government where neither revenues nor expenditures exceed five hundred thousand dollars may, with the approval of the State Auditor, be exempt from the provision of Section 29-1-603, C.R.S.; and

WHEREAS, neither revenue nor expenditures for Town of Starkville exceeded \$100,000 for Fiscal Year 2018; and

WHEREAS, an application for exemption from audit for Town of Starkville has been prepared by Dixon, Waller & Co., Inc.; a company skilled in governmental accounting; and

WHEREAS, said application for exemption from audit has been completed in accordance with regulations, issued by the State Auditor.

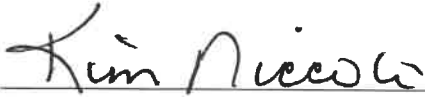
